DRIVE-IN SAFETY RULES

1. No Smoking - The hotel, State of Florida, and Necronomicon have instituted a no smoking policy. **This includes e-cigs.** The only places where con members may smoke are on designated smoking floors and outside.
2. Weapons - No real weapons, bladed weapons, or simulated weapons that can shoot a projectile are allowed. Also, if it looks like a real gun, it's not allowed. The only exception is for pre-approved Masquerade participants. All hall costume weapons and props must be approved by a member of Necronomicon staff. If you have a weapon with your hall costume, you are NOT allowed to carry it in your hands; it MUST remain in the holster/sheath or similar.
3. Harassment - Harassment is any behavior that intentionally annoys or alarms another person. This includes any unwanted physical contact, following someone around, rude, suggestive, or insulting comments, or otherwise infringing on their personal liberties or space. This activity will not be tolerated at Necronomicon. Remember that if you approach someone and they tell you "no" or to leave them alone, your business with them is done.
 - * If you do not leave them alone as they have requested, your actions may be grounds for a complaint of harassment.
 - * If you feel that you are being harassed, report the matter immediately to convention staff or security.
4. Badges - ID badges must be worn prominently on the front of clothing and above the waist at all times. Anyone without a badge will be refused access. If you lose your badge, you must buy a new membership to get another one, or you will be sacrificed to the Elder Gods.
5. Behavior and costumes must adhere to Hillsborough County decency laws.
6. Quiet time, except for the first floor, is 10 PM to 10 am. For the comfort and convenience of all hotel guests, during these hours you are required to keep noise to a minimum on all sleeping floors.

7. Disorderly Conduct - No running in the hotel, yelling, fighting, or damaging of hotel and/or convention property will be tolerated. Drunken or disorderly conduct in Necronomicon function space will result in the member being escorted to his or her room or removed from the hotel.
 8. Alcohol shall not be dispensed in public or function areas of the hotel except by authorized hotel staff.

SHANNON MAYER

Shannon Mayer was born into a family of *Star Wars* nuts and was subjected to *Star Wars* marathons on a regular basis.

She lives in the southwestern tip of Canada with her husband, son, dog, cats, horse, and cows. When not writing she spends her time staring at immense amounts of rain, herding old people (similar to herding cats) and attempting to stay out of trouble. Especially that last is difficult for her.

She graduated from the Farrier Program at Kwantlen University College in Surrey, British Columbia, and spent some time shoeing horses for a living.

She is the *USA Today*, *Wall Street Journal*, and *Washington Post* bestselling author of multiple Urban Fantasy series, including the “Rylee Adamson” novels, the “Elemental” series, the “Nevermore Trilogy,” “A Celtic Legacy” series and several contemporary romances. She claimed the #1 spot on Amazon with her “Shadowspell Academy” series (co-written with KF Breene).

Under the pseudonym Emma Dawn, Shannon writes the “Stairway to Harem” series of paranormal romance novels.





BRINKE STEVENS

Stevens was born in San Diego and grew up in Crest, California. She studied several foreign languages, including Esperanto, and gained a Bachelor of Science in Biology and Psychology and a Master of Science in Marine Biology from Scripps Institute of Oceanography.

Initially intending to study dolphin communication, she was instead tossed out of Scripps for doing “forbidden research” on dolphin communication,

largely to do with the Navy’s use of dolphins in undersea weapons research at the time.

In 1974, Stevens attended San Diego Comic Con and won first place in the first Masquerade. She was part of running the masquerade at Comic Con for years after her win.

A photographer saw a picture of Stevens in the costume and later photographed her for the cover of the first issue of *Femme Fatales* (1992). While going to a modeling assignment, Stevens was discovered by a producer who cast her in a film as an extra. Stevens’ first speaking role was in *The Slumber Party Massacre* (1982).

Stevens has appeared in more than 100 feature films, primarily in the genres of horror, sci-fi, and fantasy. She has gained notoriety as a scream queen. In addition to acting, Stevens has co-written a number of screenplays, co-produced two documentaries, and served as an on set decorator. In the 1990’s, she was twice Guest of Honor at Necronomicon.

In Memorium

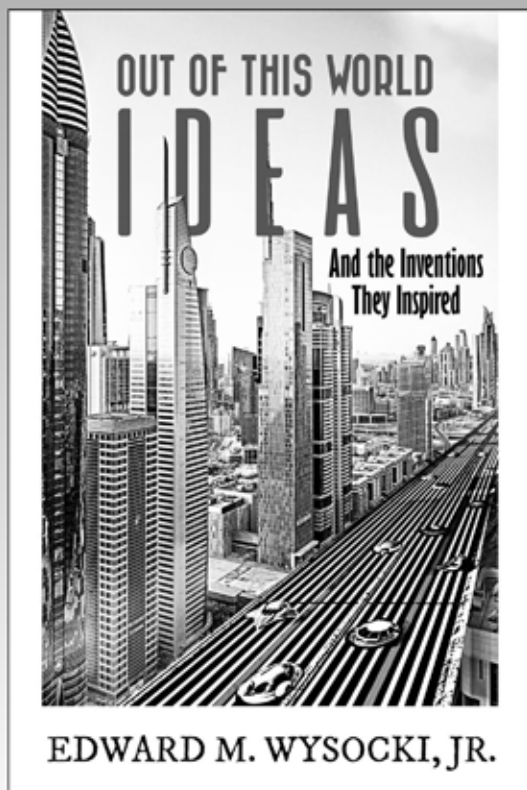
In 2018, Necronomicon and Stone Hill lost two dear friends.

ON LOCATION

“THE MOST DANGEROUS GAMES”

While planning the Marathon, the organizers were approached by two people in snappy black suits. They informed us that there **WOULD** be a special area reserved for “Games of Various Styles.” After some strange flash of light, we realized this would be a great idea! So the area by the tall tree we call the “Grand Palm” will be reserved for those who like to roll various polygonal shapes and do battle with villains of all types. Our esteemed colleagues have explained how this area will function. Below is what you will need to know to participate.

*“With the auspices of the Multicultural Initiative Bureau, a protected zone will be in effect for the duration of this Movie Marathon. Said duration will be from **Friday at 4 PM** until **Sunday at 4 PM**. All life forms present will adhere to the following rules or ejected, dismissed, deported, disincorporated, disassembled or otherwise “inconvenienced with extreme prejudice.” Authority figures will be available for scheduling and inquiries at the “**Gaming Info Table**” from the **Hours of 3 PM to 9 PM Friday, 9 AM to 9 PM Saturday and 9 AM to 1 PM Sunday**. Schedules of games will be available in hardcopy form at the Gaming Info Table.”*

- Sign-up sheets will be available 1 hour prior to start time (exceptions are games starting after 10 PM and before 10 AM, these go out at 9 PM Friday and Saturday nights)
- You may only sign YOUR OWN NAME on the sign-up sheets.
- If you sign up for a game, please report to the table on time. If you are not there at the start time your place will be awarded to the first alternate on the list. If you miss the sign-up period (or are an alternate) you can still show up at the start time & if the game isn't full the GM will allow you to play. (Alternates first, then first come first serve)
- All convention members may reserve open tables on a first come first serve basis, subject to con rules (visit Gaming Info to sign up)

- All games & demos MUST start and end on time.
- The GM is the final judge in the awarding of any prizes, if applicable (prizes provided by GM in these cases)
- No loud or disruptive behavior outside of the context of your game.
- Do NOT swap table numbers in gaming room without prior approval from gaming staff.
- BADGES MUST be worn and VISIBLE at all times while playing!
- No alcoholic beverages in gaming area.
- No food in gaming area (hotel rule)
- No smoking in any convention area.
- NO SELLING in the gaming area.


“THE IGOR/YGOR PARTY”

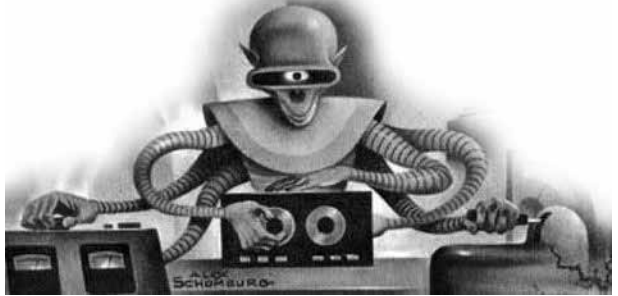

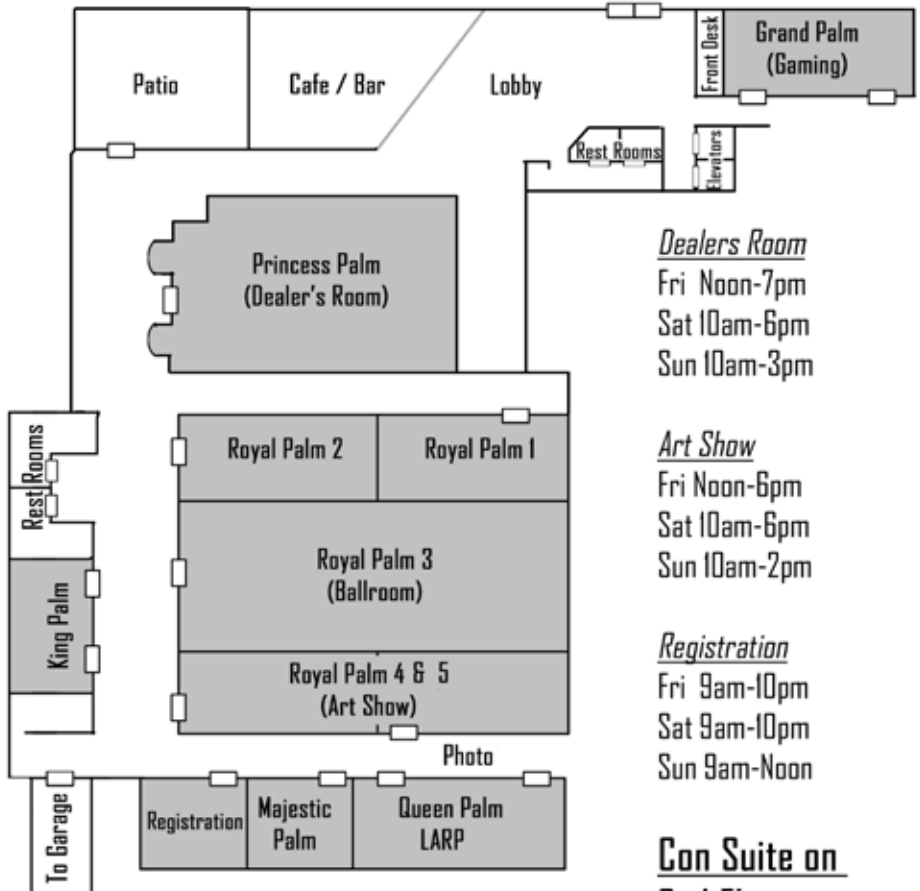

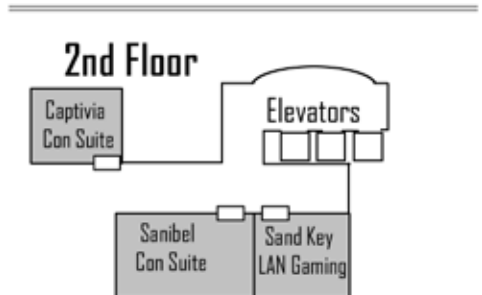
