


## Geography of Samson's Campaigns

#### The Riddle חידה H2420 and the Prize

#### Ancient money:

- 1 Talent = 60 manehs (KJV "pounds")
- 1 "pound" = 60 shekels
- 1 shekel = 8-12 grams
- The value ratio of gold to silver ranges from 2 (Egypt) to 12 (first century Rome), 4 or 5 in Phoenicia and Syria during OT times
