Tips

If you plan to drink: Don't drive

- Call a cab, use the SaferRide app, or call someone else.
- Walking impaired is dangerous

If you plan to drive: Don't drink

- > Refrain from any alcoholic beverages. People are relying on you.
- Ensure all passengers' seat belts are buckled.

If you host the Super Bowl party:

- Designate a responsible sober driver or offer to drive guests home.
- Encourage guests to pace themselves and offer non-alcoholic drinks.
- Do not serve alcohol to minors

Know the risks:

- Alcohol-impaired-driving crashes, account for 29 percent of all crash fatalities.
- > 1 alcohol-impaired-driving fatality occurred every 51 minutes.
- > The average DUI court case costs approximately \$10,000.
