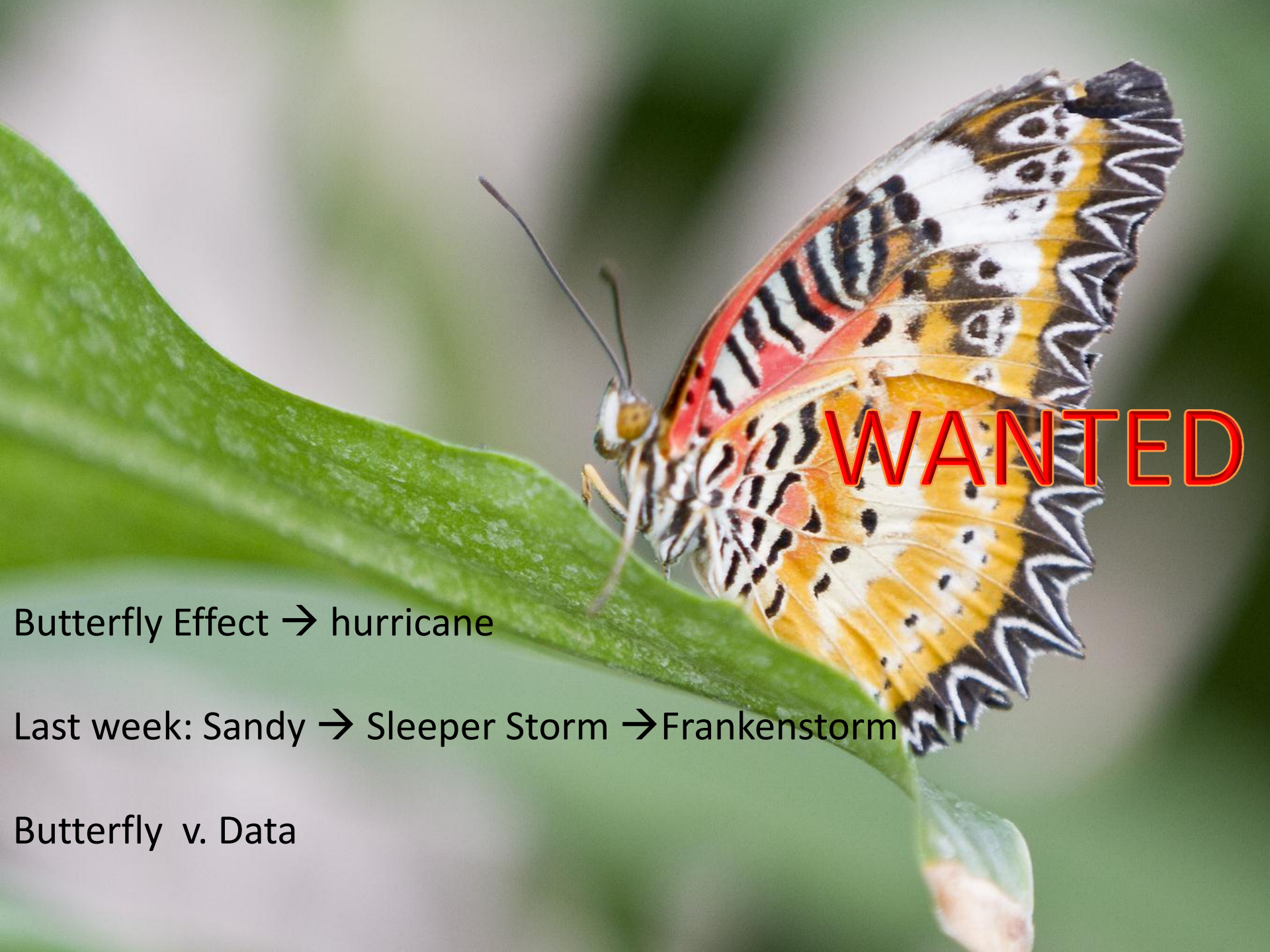
## FIGHTING CLIMATE CHANGE IS DRIVING GLOBAL TRANSFORMATIONAL CHANGE

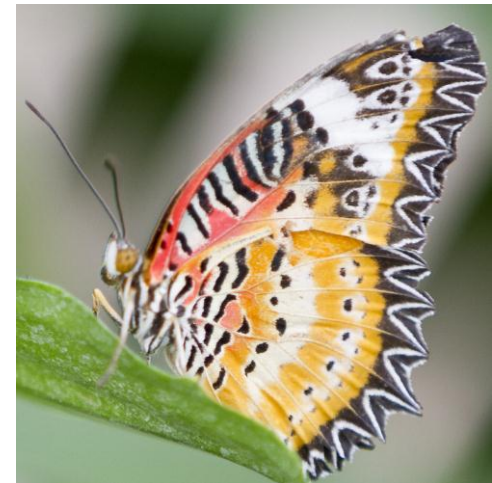
