

Instruction for ERISAN ERGP70UP

The Instruction shows how to connect iOS/Android with ERGP70UP, and Frequent Asked Questions. (Page 2&3 are Instruction for iOS, Page 4&5&6 are Instruction for Android)

QUESTION 1: How to Make the Image Upside Down, I need to Ceiling Mount the projector?

Answer: Power on the projector, please press the Menu button, then press right button to enter in the "OPTION", there you will see the "Rotate", press "OK" button to have the image flip down. (You can use the remote to set it up, it's more convenient.)

QUESTION 2: How to connect to Internet, how to connect with Bluetooth speaker?

Answer: Power on the projector, please press the Input Signal Button to select "Android" mode and press OK button to confirm. Then go to the Settings(It's in the left down corner of the screen), there the first one is WiFi, the second one is Bluetooth.

Enter in the WiFi, and wait about 3-5 seconds, it will show the WiFi hot-spots around you, connect to the spot with your Password.

Enter in the Bluetooth, in the up right corner of the screen, please switch on the Bluetooth feature, and click "Search for devices". it will begin to search for the Bluetooth speaker around it, once it shows your Bluetooth speaker, please click, then the projector will pair with your speaker.

QUESTION 3: Why Bluetooth speaker does not work after connected DVD player/PlayStation?

Answer: As Bluetooth Feature is in Android Mode, so Bluetooth feature will be switched off when in HDMI / VGA/ AV modes.

QUESTION 4: Netflix/YouTube APP do not work?

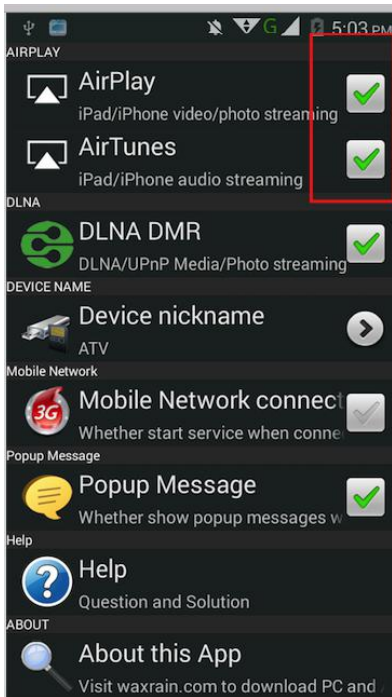

Part I : How to connect iOS(iPhone, iPad, Mac) with ERISAN ERGP70UP

We will first need to Install the AirPin app on the projector, its free of cost and can be downloaded from the link below – Click here to Download AirPin app for Android from Google Play.

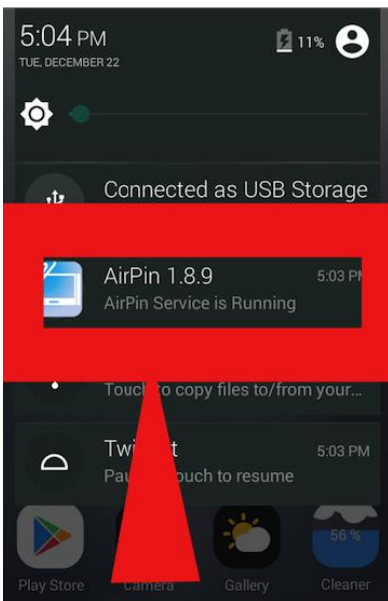
Now, In order to use AirPlay on ERGP70UP for reception purposes, Please Make Sure both your projector and the iOS device (iPhone / iPod or Mac OS) should be on the same WiFi network.



Once you have installed the AirPin lite app for Android, launch the app (Download & copy the AirPin App in a U-Disk, install it in the Projector).

Now, it will show you the list of streaming Services available as shown in the alongside image.

Here make sure that the AirPlay, AirTunes and DLNA DMR “**Checkboxes are enabled or ticked**” (*Enable Them if not Enabled*).



Now, pull down the Notification bar from the Top, and check for the notification “ **AirPin service is running**” as shown in the image below

Steps to Set-Up ERGP70UP as AirPlay & DLNA Receiver

If the AirPin Service is running!, Return to the menu.

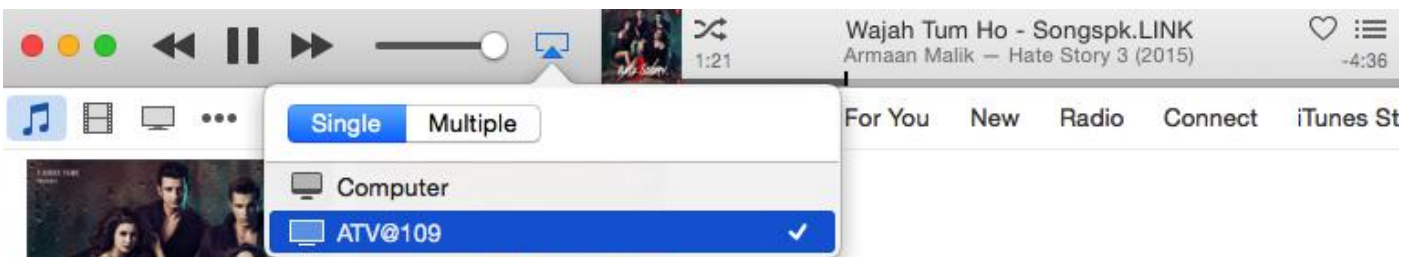
Congratulations! You have now successfully set up your projector as an DLNA Receiver. Now Simply Scan for devices to cast to in your Media Streamer and select the Nickname "ATP @ xx" to directly stream media wireless to your projector.

Example – In order to Use Android Device as Apple TV or AirPlay Receiver

We connected both the projector and MacBook on the same WiFi Network.

Started the AirPin service with AirPlay services enabled.

Now, An AirPlay icon was automatically shown on our Mac Task bar and also iTunes as shown below



(Android Device inside AirPlay icon on iTunes)

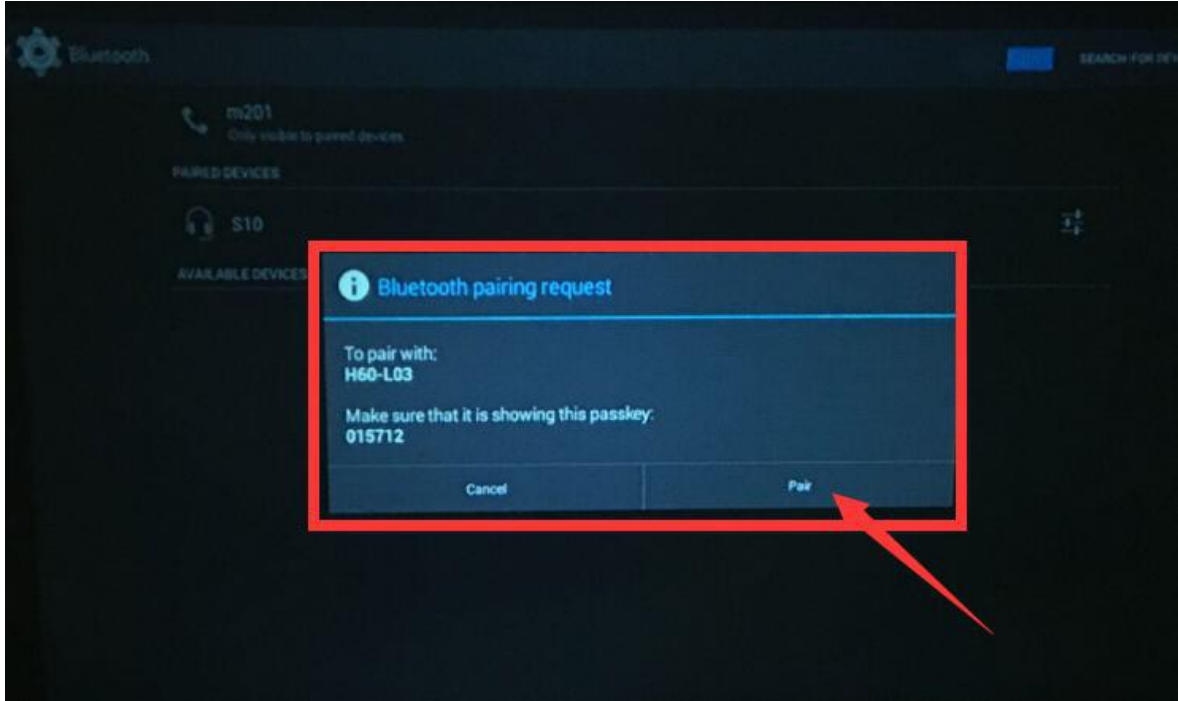
We selected our Android Device name from the available AirPlay services list as shown above .

The Android projector started playing AirPlay Streams received from Mac as shown below (We went for streaming music but you can even use it to Stream Videos and Movies to your Android Device)

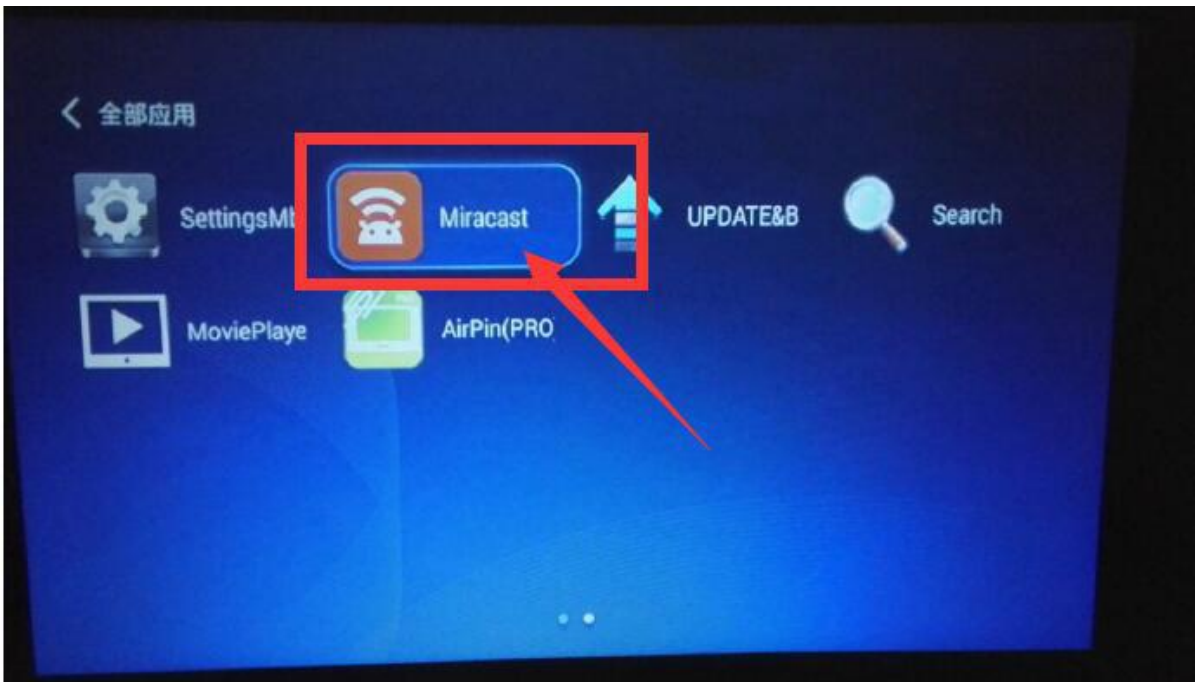
–Since Netflix, Comcast have signed the DRM(Digital Rights Management, They do not allow Airplay & Miracast Streaming–

Part I : How to connect Android (Phone, Tablet) with ERISAN ERGP70UP

Pair your device (Smart-phone, Tablet) with the projector via Bluetooth.



Open the "Miracast" in the Projector (Which is Pre-Installed in the projector).



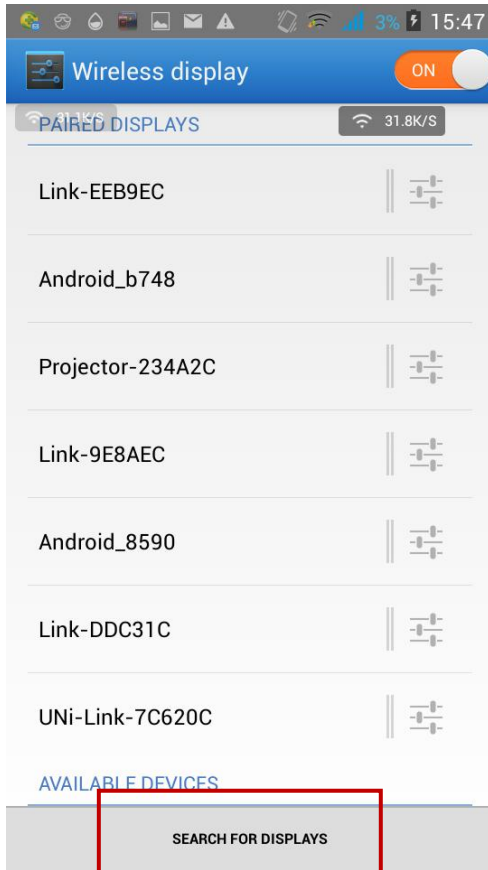


Download and Install Miracast APP from our website, Install it in your Android Phone/Tablet.
