



- The purpose of the Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) is to document overall preparedness priorities and activities for Minnesota Emergency Management.
- Incorporating all elements of the Integrated Preparedness Cycle allows for maximum efficiency of resources, time, and funding.
- This works towards improving Minnesota's capabilities.

IPPW Purpose



- Suggestion for planning team organization alternative to ICS
- Better info on planning and conduct differences between discussion-based exercises and operations-based exercises
- Suggests making corrective actions SMART, because they are objectives (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, Task oriented/Time bound)
