During this window, you <u>will</u> be expected to attend lessons in school when not completing assessments. However you may take the morning off before an afternoon assessment to revise, and the afternoon off before a morning assessment the next day similarly. Lessons will be used during this period for revision and preparation for further assessments in both this window and the next one in May. You will also be able to continue to work on any NEA.

For each assessment you will need to line up in the correct order when instructed and know your candidate number. You must have your equipment in a clear plastic bag as your bags and coats will be stored away from the desks. You may bring water with you provided it is not fizzy and is in a screw top, clear plastic bottle with the label removed. This is to help us to ensure the assessments are fair for all students.

If an assessment finishes part way through a lesson, you will be able to return to the Sixth Form area to have an opportunity to work quietly on some independent revision.



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Subject Information

For subjects not listed on the schedule it means students are either working on their Portfolio or nonexamined assessment (NEA). Students will be given further guidance in their lessons before Easter to focus and support their revision and preparation.

Biology

Business Studies A Level

There is one paper testing a range of the skills usually shown across the three papers:

- 2. Short answer questions & data response questions.
- 3. Essay style evaluative responses as per section C/D in Paper 1.

There are two papers covering:

Chemistry

There are two papers and have been organised in a different way to past papers.

- **Paper 1** based on units Developing Fuels, Oceans, Chemical Industry and Developing Metals
- **Paper 2** based on units Developing Fuels, Ozone Story, What's in a Medicine?, Polymers of Life and Colour by Design

Chinese

There are three assessments and these will cover aspects of the syllabus. The will cover:
