It hosts the Zoological Museum and has invaluable assets which are effectively used in teaching. The Department of Botany has wide collection of preserved plants, fossils, bryophytes and so on in the museum, and live plants in the spacious botanical garden. The Physics Department has a dark room for Optic Physics experiments. This is the only college in Mumbai to run Physics-Mathematics twin course at TYBSc. The Department of Mathematics conducts Mathematics courses for Science students and a Course in Mathematical and Statistical techniques for Commerce students at the undergraduate level.

The Science Departments have well-equipped and spacious laboratories with modern equipment. All the departments are equipped with departmental libraries. The faculty members are actively engaged in research and allied activities. The commendable research activities conducted by the faculty members have brought laurels to the institution.
