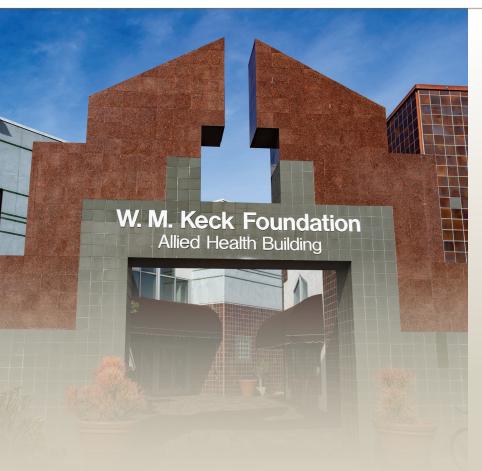
Into the Future
