PASTOR ALAN'S BACKGROUND

Alan was born and raised in the great state of Kentucky. He grew up in a Christian home where both of his parents intentionally read the Bible and pointed him to Christ. His father, a small church pastor, led Alan to the Lord at the age of 8.

Early in his teenage years, Alan sensed that God had put on his heart a desire to live his life vocationally for Him.
