## What Do Students Need in Order to Use Vocabulary Plus?

A computer, tablet device, or smartphone that has Internet access and a current web browser, such as Google Chrome, Apple Safari, Mozilla Firefox, and Microsoft Internet Explorer. Students will also need a valid subscription, which can be purchased online at any time from Townsend Press.

## How Much Does a Subscription to Vocabulary Plus Cost?
