### Message from Michelle J. Goff Executive Director, Author, International Speaker

Thank you for making 2017 such a banner year for Iron Rose Sister Ministries (IRSM)! We experienced growth in several areas and have seen this as an opportunity to take a step back and evaluate things for purposeful growth in the future. IRSM will be five years old this summer!

Being the only full-time worker with IRSM, I cannot keep up. I am extremely grateful for our Board of Directors and Erica Peck, our ministry assistant, but we are each feeling the strain of the growing pains.

As you read through the various facets of this report, please join us in prayer for God's guidance and wisdom as we prune some branches of our

rose bush. The positive side of this is the **affirmation that we are meeting a tremendous need to equip more women to connect to God and one another more deeply, across the Americas.** May you, too, be inspired, encouraged, and equipped through this report.

Here are the top areas of growth and the ways in which we covet your prayers:

- 1) **Invitations to more international locations for speaking engagements than we can accept**. Women are hungry for the teaching, encouragement, and materials that equip them to connect to God and one another more deeply. We need wisdom to continue to follow Paul's pattern from his missionary journeys of initial visit, follow-up visit, continued contact, and a third visit a few years later.
- 2) Local and international mentoring opportunities. 2 Timothy 2:2 and Christ's example affirm our goal of teaching to teach to teach. The more we equip and inspire, others are encouraged and challenged to equip and inspire... multiplication growth, as God designed (see Ana's story on pg. 5).
- 3) **No new book in 2018.** We have determined that we will not publish new interactive Bible study materials in 2018, but will, rather, focus our efforts on spreading the word about our current resources and preparing ourselves in other areas of purposeful growth.
- 4) **Recruiting more workers.** We invite you and others to join our team as we continue to equip more women. (A full list of some of our current needs is on page 6).

5) **Evaluation** of what we do and how we do it. We understand that we are stewards of the funds we receive from our supporters. As such, we are working to affirm that the highest possible percentage

of those resources is always used directly in helping Christian women to connect to God and one another more deeply.






