Wild Game Is Nutritious

FRENCH CREEK, W.Va. — West Virginia's abundance of wildlife and hunting seasons provide opportunities for many families to fill their freezers with highly nutritious wild game.

Wild game provides a low-fat, high-protein alternative to beef or other commercial meats. For example, white-tailed deer (venison) contains fewer calories and approximately five times less fat than the equivalent serving of beef.

"Hunting is a great reason to get into the woods, stretch your legs,

and may result in a freezer full of healthy protein," said Kaylee Pollander, wildlife biologist for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. "With the diversity of game available for legal harvest, there is something for everyone's taste."

Hunters and their families are not the only West Virginians who benefit from the state's abundant supply of wild game. The DNR-sponsored Hunters Helping the Hungry (HHH) Program processes deer for needy families and individuals in the Mountain State.

Since the program's inception in 1992, approximately 1,003,208 pounds of venison have been donated. In 2018 alone, 685 deer (23,659 pounds of nutritious venison) were donated to the HHH Program.

Special Four - Day Split Antlerless Season

FRENCH CREEK, W.Va. - The four-day special split antlerless deer season for youth hunters, persons with a Class Q/QQ permit, and senior citizens with a Class XS license soon will be underway.

The first segment of the season was Oct. 19–20. The second segment is Dec. 26–27. Hunting is permitted on private and public lands in counties that have a firearms deer hunting season.



Youth hunters ages 8–17 may participate in this special antlerless deer season. Hunters ages 8–14 must be accompanied by a licensed adult who may not hunt or possess implements for the taking of wildlife. Hunters ages 15–17 must comply with all licensing requirements. Senior hunters who have a resident Class XS lifetime hunting/trapping/fishing license may also participate in this special antlerless deer season.

"This is an excellent opportunity to pass on the tradition and safe practices of hunting to youth hunters," said Tyler Evans, wildlife biologist with the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR). "This season also provides a tremendous opportunity for seniors and hunters with a Class Q/QQ permit to enjoy this unique hunting experience at

a time when there is not as much hunting pressure."

All hunters participating in this season, as well as accompanying adults, must wear at least 400 square inches of blaze orange.

Nonresident youth hunters must be properly licensed (Class XXJ Li-

cense + CS/LE Stamp, Class AAHJ License + CS/LE Stamp, or a Class DT License), and all accompanying nonresident adults must also be properly licensed (Class E License + CS/LE Stamp).

The daily bag limit for this special antlerless deer season is one antlerless deer per day, for a total of four antlerless deer that may be harvested during this season.

NOTE: The chart on Page 2 of the 2019–2020 Hunting and Trapping Regulations incorrectly states

that the possession and season bag limits are three instead of four. The correct season bag limit of four reflects one antlerless deer per day as stated above.

Deer harvested during the special split antlerless season will not count toward a hunter's annual deer season bag limit. Class N/NN stamps are not required for this special season.

Each deer must be field tagged and electronically registered within 24 hours of the close of each segment of the split season, and before pursuit of any additional deer. Deer can

be checked online at wvhunt.com, by calling 1-844-WVCHECK, or by visiting a license agent.

Please refer to the 2019–2020 West Virginia Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary for additional details about this special antlerless season. Hunters may also direct their questions to any of the six DNR district offices.

2019 DNR Mast Survey

ELKINS, W.Va. — Hunters can get help preparing for the fall hunting seasons by consulting the 2019 Mast Survey and Hunting Outlook publication, available on the Division of Natural Resources website HERE. Information analyzing mast conditions and wildlife harvests

also is available on the website.

Since 1971, the Wildlife Resources Section of DNR, in cooperation with volunteers from numerous other agencies, has conducted a fall mast survey to determine the abundance of mast produced by 18 species of trees and shrubs.

Production of black/red oak acorns, apple and black cherry is significantly higher than the past year and will have effects on the 2019–2020 hunting seasons, according to the report. White and chestnut oak are down significantly from last year and well below their long-term average.

"The availability of fall foods has significant impacts on wildlife populations and harvests," said Chris Ryan, supervisor of the Game Management Services of DNR's Wildlife Resources Section. "It is very important for hunters to scout

and consider the type and amount of food available in the areas they hunt. Hunters can find a wealth of facts in the Mast Survey and Hunting Outlook, and it should provide them valuable information before heading into the field."


That's right. Without the efforts of hunters, many of the animals that are abundant today would have dwindling populations. The next time an anti-hunter says we are killing too many wild animals, share some of this information.

8. Hunters keep nuisance species in check and keep herd numbers healthy for various other animals.

Wildlife management has never been this important, with development encroaching into habitat on an exponential scale. Natural predators are one thing, but when the introduction of invasive species or prevalence of nuisances, it becomes a matter of life or death for a lot of game animals.

9. Sport hunting in Zambia provides 143 tons of meat to rural villages with an estimated value of \$600,000.

A study done by two individuals found that African sport hunting offers great benefits to the inhabitants of the land. Most times the rural natives are happy when a dangerous animal is harvested, because the village becomes safer. 10. At the end of the day, "I"ll never apologize for being a hunter."



Deer Scents Unmasked

Making sense out of deer scents can make or break your season before it even gets started.

If you happen to walk through a sports store right before deer season opens up in your state, you will see more sprays, scents, cans, and wafers than most hunters can shake a stick at.

Some of these products are gimmicks designed to bag the hunter long before they will ever help a hunter bag a deer, but some can be highly useful tools that bring a buck running.

If you plan to use deer scents on your hunt, it vital that you understand what deer scents work best during specific times of the season. Opening Day

During the early part of the season, bucks are still not actively

chasing does. Instead, they are sparing and marking their territories by making rubs and

scrapes. This is the time to break out a bottle of buck urine.

The goal of the buck urine is to catch the nose of a buck that is already in the area and make him continue to page 14

curious enough of the new smell to want to investigate and size up competition. This is a time when setting up on scrapes and rubs can be effective, and often deadly, when coupled with this uniquely powerful scent.gamecamera2

Mixing in a combination of doe urine is also very effective because it tells the buck that is investigating that everything is fine in the area and safe to proceed. Notice the velvet on this early season buck to the right.

Pre-Rut

Bucks are now getting much more aggressive and looking to challenge other bucks to set up a pecking order when does come into heat. Using buck urine on a drag line is the way to go.

If you happen to hunt an open field or have a wide area around your tree stand or blind, walking away from your set up and walking back with a drag strip covered in buck urine can stop a cruising buck in it's tracks and bring him right to you.

Rut

Rut is often the time when bucks throw caution to the wind and chase anything that smells like a doe in heat. Just like the two scent combos in the early season, a mix of dominant buck urine and doe estrous can drive any nearby buck to the point of tears.



around your stand to add extra scent to the air can bring a buck several hundred yards away to try to find a ready doe. Sprinkling more dominant buck urine in the area can send a buck into a stomping rage. On the picture to the left, this buck is licking the air trying find a doe in heat.

the area tired out from a few weeks of flurry, their main concentration begins to switch back to food. Doe urine is back on the game plan as bucks are seeking bedding areas and a place to grab a bite to eat. Just like before, as they pass an area with doe urine, they tend to lower their guard, possibly opening up a shot.

In order for any of these scents to work, the human odor factor has to be minimized the best it can. In these cases, cover sprays and scent eliminators are designed to reduce human scent so the deer scents can be allowed to work their magic.

I have found that scent eliminators, such as Bucked Scent Eliminator, works better than cover scents in most situations. Trying to fool a deer's nose by importing a smell into their living room that is powerful enough to overpower human odor can sometimes have the opposite effect the hunter wants. Eliminating odor in the first place is just the best option.

Be wary of other cover sprays with added smells such as earth, apple, acorn, etc. If those smells

are not naturally in your area, you very well may not even see a deer because they will take that strange odor as a warning and be two counties away before you even reach your stand.



Hunting Funnels & Pinch Points

Funnels and pinch points play as vital of role in your whitetail success as a productive food plot program.

Sure, food lures deer in like free food samples at a giant box store, but without routes that manipulate deer into ambush opportunities your food efforts may fall as flat as a kale sample at a health food store. The percentage of failure rises if local deer feel pressure and linger in timber for a nocturnal entrance to feed.

Funnels are generally defined as terrain or manmade features that channel whitetail travel activity.

Increase shooting odds by locating funnels and pinch points on your property. Deer use them as travel shortcuts and you can use them as shortcuts to success.

Funnels are generally defined as terrain or manmade features that channel whitetail travel activity.



This may include land features such as riparian zones, coulees, hillside benches and ridgetop saddles. In the manmade category it might include fences, hedgerows, planted windbreaks and seldom-used back roads.

Pinch points oftentimes exist in a funnel, but further neck down a meeting location to an x-marksthe-spot site. They include narrow creek crossings, bottlenecks of timber, cliff-side trails and an open gate along a tightly-strung fence.

In either category think the path of least resistance. Whitetails vary their travel, but generally lean toward an easy path that provides refuge.



hunting programs, like ScoutLook Weather, give you the view from above and allow topographical overlays to view terrain underneath the canopy.

These lines of elevation reveal subtle terrain features deer use to sneak between food and refuge. As you research scout for strips of narrow cover connecting large blocks of timber. Also be on the hunt for ribbons of habitat that lead to food sources or sanctuary. If you find funnels that connect, like spokes in hub, you've hit a homerun.

Narrowed Search

Next, narrow your search for pinch points in between. Obvious selections, such as constricted tree lines, stand out on satellite images and you may be able to decipher others with mapping help. Still, a walk in the woods may offer the most credible insight.

Aaron Volkmar, a 14-year veteran whitetail outfitter, believes onsite exploration is the best way to confirm funnels and pinch points. His various hunting properties in Iowa, Missouri and Kansas keep him in scouting mode much of the offseason. He suggests firsthand scouting any time of year, except hunting season. Nevertheless, he advises winter and spring scouting as his top preference if at all possible.

"The best way to scout and for the best view of funnels, and pinch points is to go out in the middle of winter. Your intrusion ate and rank travel corridors based on how many deer use them, and find the pinch points," notes Volkmar. lots of long-range glassing, especially during the summer when bachelor groups begin to form and bucks consistently feed in daylight. Volkmar is looking for bucks appearing on trails with distinct pinch-point opportunities he discovered while walking properties.

Scout and Confirm

Since Volkmar specializes in hunting mature bucks he deploys trail cameras to help inventory bucks on his properties. Despite the extra eyes in the woods, he limits his forays into the woods to check trail cameras. This is especially important if the camera is near a pinch point with a high probability for a mature buck meeting.

"If I glass an older buck or catch

one on a trail camera, the last thing I'm going to do is walk in repeatedly to check a camera. You likely only get one opportunity on a mature buck. You won't get that opportunity if you keep busting or jumping a seasoned buck."

One of Volkmar's Iowa properties is characterized by a 9-acre stand of timber that funnels through two fields into another 4-acre bowl of trees. That small habitat zone eventually dwindles to nothing in a nearby crop field. Last season Volkmar counted no less than 38 active scrapes along the corridor and he placed stands in the narrowest pinch points.

Be on the lookout for your own whitetail thoroughfare this season.

Avoid Deer Collisions

FRENCH CREEK, W.Va. - The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR) urges motorists to take extra caution while driving in the fall. On average, approximately 40% of deer-vehicle collisions in West Virginia will occur between October and December.

"West Virginia is fortunate to have an abundance of white-tailed deer," said Tyler Evans, wildlife biologist with the DNR Wildlife Resources Section. "However, populations are dense in many areas and this can increase the number of deer-vehicle collisions during the fall breeding season.

"October and November coincide with the 'rut' peak of the deer breeding season. The increase in activity and movement of deer can increase the chances a deer will collide with a vehicle. Additionally, the presence of hunters may contribute to deer movement and increase the probability of a deer-vehicle collision," Evans said

. West Virginia's rugged terrain also likely contributes to these collisions as the highest quality deer habitat is often associated with



ground and a small creek. The only structure of twentieth century construction is a big picnic shelter with a stone fireplace.

les. They learn the ancient arts of concealment and silent movement through the forest. They are taught to identify unseen animals by the calls they make and even by the distinctive way each creature rustles leaves. Kids begin stalking groundhogs and squirrels and then work up to deer and turkeys. They take pride in becoming accomplished hunters and excellent marksmen.

The first week of deer season is always the highlight of farm activities. An annual "hunter migration" begins the Friday before Thanksgiving. Family and friends start rolling in from all over the country. There's a big weekend reunion before deer season opens on Monday morning.

Opening day starts around 4 AM. Hunters awaken to a flurry of activity. Everyone is getting dressed, drinking coffee, eating breakfast and loading backpacks. Hours before daylight, they strike out in all directions - armed with rifles, sidearms and hunting knives. Most of them will have at least a half-hour hike along pitch-black trails lit only by the narrow beam of their flashlights. It's not unusual for one of our hunters to be startled by continue to the next page

by the blood-curdling calls of nearby coyotes. They are a sobering reminder that bears, bobcats and an occasional panther also hunt these woods at night. Hunters need to pay as much attention to the trail behind them as they do to what lies ahead. Guns and knives afford marginal protection against large predators that lurk in dark forests. Its not until they are safely up in their treestands that the hunters become the most feared predators in the woods..

Everyone hopes to see a trophy buck today. Maybe they will. Maybe they will choose to shoot. Maybe not. Maybe they will bring home meat or maybe a rush of adrenaline will cause them to miss

Fall Walleye Fishing

The fall months have reputations for being some of the best months of the entire year for fishing as most fish species, walleyes included, are actively feeding during this time. While big, deep lakes are often thought of as "classic" walleye waters, small, shallow lakes often harbor good walleye populations that often go on the bite now too.

Typically, I like to target fall walleyes in shallow, weedy lakes by searching along the lake's first drop-off, that area where the flat that typically extends out from shore starts to drop to deeper depths. On many of the small, shallow lakes I fish this drop-off occurs in depths from 5- to 10-feet deep.

Searching along subtle points and turns or finding bottom content changes along these drop-offs is often a good starting point. These areas are often good spots during

the spring bite on these lakes and produce again during fall. As fall progresses, I start looking for still living, green weeds which often occur grow up on the flat and then extend down the drop off as well. In fact, an area of green weeds will often be the "spot on the spot" continue to the next page

where numbers of walleyes of all sizes gather.

Incidentally, the areas where "good weeds" are present one fall, is often an area that will harbor weeds and fish in future falls as well. These areas are also often top winter ice fishing spots too, particularly during early ice.

The classic jig and minnow combination slowly trolled or drifted along a lake's first drop-off is one way to find the subtle differences and/or living weeds that may host fall walleyes in good numbers. Simply drifting with the wind and swimming a light jig and minnow combination on a long line behind the boat is, in fact, my favorite fishing method on these waters because it helps me eliminate unproductive water and find walleye schools.

Once a school of marble-eyed fish is found along the drop-off, the catch can often be maximized by anchoring, either with an anchor or with a trolling motor's "spot-lock" feature and pitching jigs and minnows repeatedly to the fish. Shallow water pitching is a great way to

work over a spot and catch a bunch of fish from a small area.

Jigs in the 1/16- and 1/8-ounce size range get the nod when drifting or pitching to shallow walleyes. The classic Fire-Ball® Jig is available in these sizes and comes in a bunch of "fishy" colors as well. Various minnows will produce fall walleyes, but a scoop of fatheads is often all that is needed. On flat calm days or in very shallow water, the 1/16-ounce size Fire-Ball® gets the nod, though I'll go to the 1/8-ounce size if the wind kicks up. Incidentally, the Fire-Ball® will soon be available in several UV color patterns that will make these jigs even more appealing to fish in the off-colored waters often found in many small, shallow lakes.

Light jigs and minnows fish well on light line and spinning rods and reels..

If you are looking for some perfect fall fishing fun this year, consider heading to a small, shallow lake right now. Tie on a jig and minnow and look for the spots just described.


