



NETA AWARD FINALISTS INCLUDE WTVP COVID-19 AND EASTERSEALS CAMPAIGNS

The excellence viewers and supporters have come to expect from WTVP has been recognized by the National Educational Telecommunications Association (NETA) through its 52nd Annual Public Media Awards. WTVP has finalists in two award categories:

COVID-19 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Recognition is given in this category for "exemplary community engagement services" in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. WTVP's extensive information and awareness campaign began within days of the statewide lockdown in March and includes a live, 90-minute town hall meeting; hosting a regional simulcast with commercial television stations; expanded weekly call-ins on *At Issue* with H Wayne Wilson; more than 80 Coronavirus Updates and Staying Healthy messages and official department communications.

OVERALL EXCELLENCE: WTVP/EASTERSEALS

Launched in November 2019, the **WTVP**/Easterseals Better Together campaign is designed to help children relate to people with differing abilities and to promote inclusion in everyday interactions. **WTVP** produced and continues to air two on-air messages spotlighting Easterseals clients and referring parents and caregivers to PBS Kids programming and PBS LearningMedia.

According to NETA, the Public Media Awards "honor our members' finest work in education, community engagement, marketing/communications and content." Winners will be announced in January 2021.

It is no different at **WTVP**, where we are excited about some of the changes slated to happen in our facility and broadcast schedule.

Thanks to generous donations, the programming department is looking at bringing at least one new British comedy to our main channel in 2021. For **WTVP** REMOTE, the broadcast-only channel dedicated to distance learning, our nationwide search for new content will bring programs from Tennessee and Missouri designed for various grade levels.

Inside the station, **WTVP** engineers are starting to replace outdated equipment so the number of HD (high definition) sources can be increased. This is being done in preparation for the installation of new HD studio cameras later in the year. All these plans would not be possible without your support. 



EXPANDING HORIZONS IN HIDDEN PLACES

Occasionally we get a glimpse of the impact WTVP and its five channels have on someone's life. That was the case when our Development Department received a letter and handmade thank you card from a detainee at the Illinois River Correctional Center in Canton.

After requesting and receiving a WTVP program schedule, the detainee wrote: "It is easy to believe, once you have been locked away behind prison walls, that the world has forgotten about you and/or just doesn't care. I can't begin to tell you what your act of kindness means to myself and the men I will share the monthly programming schedule with. PBS gives us an opportunity to learn new things, expand our horizons, and at times, to sail beyond these walls."

Since WTVP REMOTE went live in September 2020, WTVP has met with a number of potential users of the service, including officials at correctional facilities. The types of content that they believe would be most helpful are the types of content already on the air, helping students, detainees and others explore, learn and grow.



Look up "volunteer" in the dictionary and you are likely to find a picture of Rebekah Bourland. That's how completely she embodies the spirit of volunteerism that is at the heart of the **WTVP** Klystron Society. As a Klystron Society member, Rebekah's investment continues the impact on culture, the arts and education started a generation before by her parents.

When Phil Weinberg turned to the community to find the resources to create **WTVP**, the first person he called was Rebekah's mother, Jane. She hosted fundraising teas and events and twisted the right arms to help secure the resources to launch the station. Jane and her husband, Fredrick, also helped raise interest in the business community, and they both continued their involvement with the station throughout their lives. Imagine my surprise when I came home from Northwestern University on my first college break to see a color set in the living room! That's when I learned that my mother had become a disciple of Phil Weinberg. She and my dad were inveterate Channel 47 viewers from that time forward."

Rebekah says she is a **WTVP** Klystron Society member and continues to support the station because it is always educational and informative and watching the programs maximizes your time. She also loves the arts and knows her investment in **WTVP** will continue to enrich the community for generations to come. The grandson of Alabama slaves, Julian won worldwide acclaim for his research in chemistry and broke the color barrier in American science more than a decade before Jackie Robinson did so in baseball. He discovered a way to turn soybeans into synthetic steroids on an industrial scale, enabling drugs like cortisone to be widely available to millions. In a special two-hour presentation, *NOVA* traces the vivid and moving saga of Julian's dazzling scientific achievements and sometimes stormy personal life. His largely unknown story is brought to life with vivid period re-enactments based on newly accessible family archives and interviews with dozens of colleagues and relatives.
