Is. 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

- **Isaiah prophesied that this same Jesus would come and be the Savior for all mankind 700 years before His birth.**

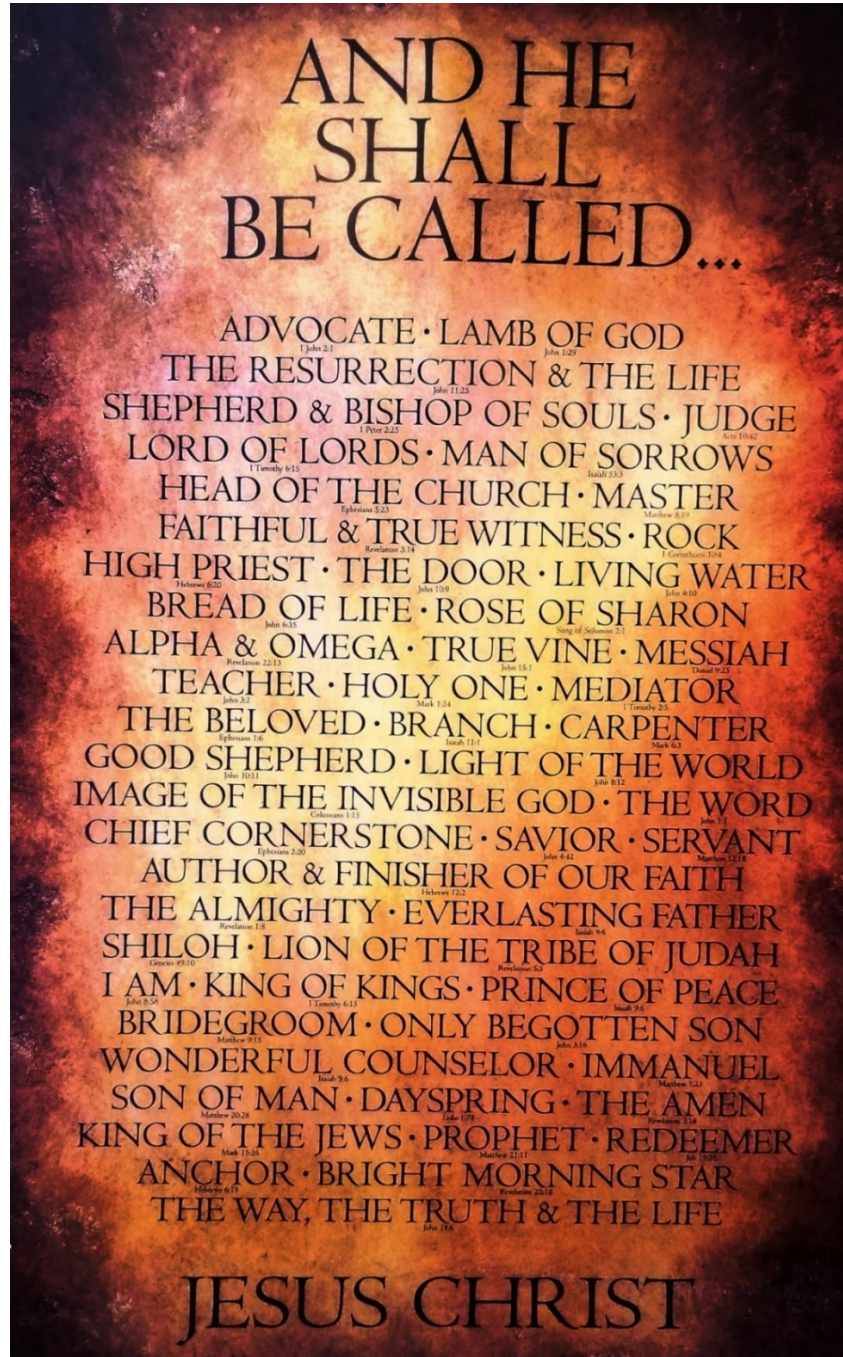

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

Jesus is The (Way) of Blood Covenant

Blood cut covenant necessitates a living sacrifice, and the Way of Covenant involves curses and blessings/better promises. God said, “I will bless them that bless thee and curse him that curseth thee” (Gen 12:2-3). Paul said Jesus “is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises” (Heb. 8:6). God’s covenant with Abram prepared the way of Jesus through blood. Jesus said, “I am the way, the truth, and the life” (John 14:6). God said, “number *the stars*, so shall thy seed be, and the LORD made a covenant with Abram” (Gen. 15:1, 4-5, 10, 18).

Gen. 15:9-10 And he said unto him (Abram), Take me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old, and a ram of three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon. And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not.

Gen. 15:17-18 And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates...

- **God is “the One who walked between the (animal) pieces and obligated Himself to bring all the blessings of the Abrahamic covenant” (Gen. 15:9-21).¹**

Jesus is The Absolute (Truth)

John 8:32 **And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.**

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Phil. 4:7-9 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things *are* honest, whatsoever things *are* just, whatsoever things *are* pure, whatsoever things *are* lovely, whatsoever things *are* of good report; if *there be* any virtue, and if *there be* any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Heb. 6:17-19 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which *it was impossible for God to lie*, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: Which *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Jesus is The Resurrection (Life)

John 11:25-27 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

1 Pet. 1:18-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

- **Jesus paid your sin tax with His own blood**

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

When you trust in all that Jesus God with us is - you will find...

- **Jesus Is the wind beneath our sails**
- **Jesus Is the calm within our storm**
- **Jesus Is the captain of our salvation**

Jesus Is the (wind) beneath our sails

Num. 11:31 GW The LORD sent a wind from the sea that brought quails and dropped them all around the camp. There were quails on the ground about three feet deep as far as you could walk in a day in any direction.

Num. 11:31 YLT And a spirit hath journeyed from Jehovah, and cutteth off quails from the sea, and leaveth by the camp, as a day's journey here, and as a day's journey there, round about the camp, and about two cubits, on the face of the land.

John 3:8 TPT For the Spirit-wind blows as it chooses. You can hear its sound, but you don't know where it came from or where it's going. So it is within the hearts of those who are Spirit-born!"

- **You are Spirit born – not by your own works**

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

Jesus Is the (calm) within our storm

John 16:32-33 Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

- **Not every wind comes from God**

Mark 4:39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, **Peace, be still.** And the wind ceased, and **there was a great calm.**

Jesus Is the (Captain) of our salvation

Heb. 2:10 For it became him, for whom *are* all things, and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation **perfect** through sufferings.

Heb. 2:10 GW God is the one for whom and through whom everything exists. Therefore, while God was bringing many sons and daughters to glory, it was the right time to bring Jesus, the source of their salvation, to the end of his work through suffering.

Heb. 5:8-9 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

Acts 17:28 For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

Acts 17:28 TPT It is through him that we live and function and have our identity; just as your own poets have said, ‘Our lineage comes from him.’

John 14:21 TPT Those who truly love me are those who obey my commands. Whoever passionately loves me will be passionately loved by my Father. And I will passionately love you in return and will manifest my life within you.”

- **The deposit of the Holy Spirit inside of you**

Eph. 1:12-14 NIV in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God’s possession - to the praise of his glory.

2 Cor. 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

John 14:22 TPT Then one of the disciples named Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said, “Lord, why is it you will only reveal your identity to us and not to everyone?”

John 14:23 TPT Jesus replied, “Loving me empowers you to obey my word. And my Father will love you so deeply that we will come to you and make you our dwelling place.”

1 Cor. 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

John 14:24 TPT But those who don’t love me will not obey my words. The Father did not send me to speak my own revelation, but the words of my Father.

John 14:25 TPT I am telling you this while I am still with you.

John 14:26 TPT But when the Father sends the Spirit of Holiness, the One like me who sets you free, he will teach you all things in my name. And he will inspire you to remember every word that I’ve told you.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 14:27 TPT “I leave the gift of peace with you - my peace. Not the kind of fragile peace given by the world, but my perfect peace. Don’t yield to fear or be troubled in your hearts— instead, be courageous!”

John 14:28 TPT “Remember what I’ve told you, that I must go away, but I promise to come back to you. So if you truly love me, you will be glad for me, since I’m returning to my Father, who is greater than I.

John 14:29 TPT So when all of these things happen, you will still trust and cling to me.

John 14:30 TPT I won’t speak with you much longer, for the ruler of this dark world is coming. But he has no power over me, *for he has nothing to use against me.*

John 14:31 TPT I am doing exactly what the Father destined for me to accomplish, so that the world will discover how much I love my Father. Now come with me.”

1 Tim. 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus

Ps. 103:17 But the mercy of the LORD *is* from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children’s children.

Jesus Is your Comfort and Joy

John 14:26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

1 Pet. 1:6-9 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see *him* not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: Receiving the end of your faith, *even* the salvation of *your* souls.

1 Pet. 1:7-9 MSG Pure gold put in the fire comes out of it *proved* pure; genuine faith put through this suffering comes out *proved* genuine. When Jesus wraps this all up, it’s your faith, not your gold, that God will have on display as evidence of his victory. You never saw him, yet you love him. You still don’t see him, yet you trust him - with laughter and singing. Because you kept on believing, you’ll get what you’re looking forward to: total salvation.

2 Chron. 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart *is* perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

Heb. 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

1 Pet. 1:8-9 AMP Without having seen Him, you love Him; though you do not [even] now see Him, you believe in Him and exult and thrill with inexpressible and glorious (triumphant, heavenly) joy. [At the same time] you receive the result (outcome, consummation) of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

- **Mary's faith was impregnated because of her faith and speaking**

Luke 1:38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; **be it unto me according to thy word.** And the angel departed from her.

- **Mary became the embodiment of joy unspeakable and full of glory**

1 Pet. 1:8-9 Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see *him* not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: Receiving the end of your faith, *even* the salvation of *your* souls.

- **Because of Mary's faith, Jesus came "unto us" Emmanuel God with us**
- **Not only is Jesus the Captain of my salvation...**
- **I choose to serve and please Him because of His faithfulness to me**
- **As His soldier - I must be about my Father's business**

Luke 2:49 And he said unto them, **How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?**

- **You cannot do it alone in this world without Him**

Heb. 11:6 TPT And **without faith living 'within us' it would be impossible to please God.** For we come to God in faith knowing that he is real and that he rewards the faith of those who give all their passion and strength into seeking him.

Heb. 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

- **I cannot but lovingly serve Him**
- **In His service (Presence) is fullness of joy!**

Ps. 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

- **My greatest fascination is in Jesus Christ**
- **John 14:6** Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

- **I am thankful for Him because He has redeemed from the mess I was in and broke me away from this cruel world and “called me” into His service**

2 Tim. 2:4 AMP No soldier in active service gets entangled in the [ordinary business] affairs of civilian life; [he avoids them] so that he may please the one who enlisted him to serve.

- **Do not be held captive**

2 Tim. 2:26 And *that* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

2 Tim. 2:2-7 MSG So, my son, throw yourself into this work for Christ. Pass on what you heard from me - the whole congregation saying Amen! - to reliable leaders who are competent to teach others. When the going gets rough, take it on the chin with the rest of us, the way Jesus did. A soldier on duty doesn't get caught up in making deals at the marketplace. He concentrates on carrying out orders. An athlete who refuses to play by the rules will never get anywhere. It's the diligent farmer who gets the produce. Think it over. God will make it all plain.

2 Tim. 2:2 NIV And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

Matt. 4:4 But he answered and said, **It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

Rev. 19:16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

1 Pet. 2:9 But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Eph. 1:13 In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Rom. 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- **Jesus is God’s Gift for you**

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

Eph. 2:6 And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus:

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

- Jesus says, “I Am God with you if you will let Me”

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- **Your active part – align your heart with your mouth**

Rom. 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
