Three-year-old Coronado's Quest closes out his career looking for his first victory against older horses. The winner of the GI Buick Haskell Invitational and GI Travers, he ran a big race in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last out, setting the pace before tiring late to be fifth, beaten only two lengths. The Janney homebred is a perfect four-for-four at Aqueduct including his lone start at a mile, last year's GIII Nashua S. Hoping to earn points toward the Eclipse Award as champion sprinter here, Affirmed Success took the GII Forego H. and GI Vosburgh, both at seven furlongs, before pressing the pace, but fading to sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. He stretches out beyond seveneighths for the first time since running seventh in last year's 10-furlong Travers. Stormin Fever picked up the first graded-stakes win of his career taking the Nov. 7 GIII Sport Page H. going seven furlongs. He finished second by a length and a half in the Vosburgh at level weights, but gets a three-pound shift in his favor for this start.

The runner-up after drifting out during the stretch drive of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last time out, Silver Charm was odds-on to earn the victory this time, but had to work hard for the score. The '97 Kentucky Derby and '98 Dubai World Cup hero went up after the lead at the start, battled head-and-head with MGISW Wild Rush through honest early fractions and put that one away in the final furlong, but had to fight off a gallant late charge from longshot Littlebitlively, who was getting 11 pounds, to take the photo. "He's something," winning jockey Gary Stevens told the Daily Racing Form. "Inside the furlong pole, I thought we were beat, but then he found another gear." Bobby Barnett, who trains the runner-up, added, "Son of a gun, I hate to be disappointed about running second to a horse like that, but gosh, I thought we had him."

On the board in every start since getting a two-month vacation from March to May, Catinca was bidding for her fourth straight score and her third consecutive graded-stakes win. Stretching out after a convincing victory in the GII First Flight H. Nov. 7, the dark bay shadowed Dixie Flag (Dixieland Band) for a half, took over after six furlongs and proved much the best in the drive to the wire. "She's winning with such command that you know there's more horse left," said trainer John Kimmel. "As we increase the distance, we'll be going into new territory and we'll see how far she can go. I don't think she'll have a problem going a mile and an eighth. She'll get some time off now." The threeyear-old will take a break at Payson Park and make her next start during the Gulfstream Park meet.

Fifth in the Fall Highweight last year, Punch Line took a little stab at retirement following that race but was unhappy on the farm, according to trainer Billy Turner, and returned to the races with a July 3 allowance win at Belmont. With just one loss in four starts in his comeback, a narrow neck defeat in the Chesapeake S. at Colonial Downs Sept. 12, and a win in his last, the Oct. 17 GII Forest Hills H., the eight-year-old was made the 9-5 choice to earn back-to-back graded wins. Hustled out to an early lead, he opened up daylight through the stretch en route to an easy score. "He likes competition and likes to beat horses," said Turner. "He's doing it at the age of eight and that's amazing." Still, his trainer said retirement may once again be in the cards for the gelding. "We'll have to do some thinking," he said. "The older he gets, the harder it is to bring him back."

SLOW START FOR GOFFS SALE The four-day Goffs November Premier Foal and Breeding Stock Sale, which began Thursday in County Kildare, Ireland, was off to a quiet start, with the average price dropping 16 percent over the first two days from last year. Irish bloodstock agent John Walsh bought the top-priced lot at Friday's second day of the auction, paying 60,000 Irish guineas (\$91,432) for a filly from the first crop of the Aga Khan's 1996 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner Ashkalani (Ire) out Adjalisa (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}). The weanling, a half-sister to stakes winner Access All Areas (Ire) (Approach The Bench {Ire}), was consigned by Abbeville and Meadow Court Studs, agent. "An Irish businessman has bought her as a foundation mare and he was happy to get her for this price," Walsh said. The sale continues today with the final foal session, to be followed by the first session of broodmares, beginning at 10 a.m.

Hawksley Hill ran a game race in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, missing by a head after a slow break, and has tallied five graded-stakes wins this season, including the April 4 GII El Rincon H. and Sept. 19 GIII Bay Meadows H. at this distance. Military was 12th in the Breeders' Cup Mile, but won three of his first four U.S. starts, taking a one-mile Hollywood allowance in June and adding the 11-furlong July 23 Kobuk King S. at Del Mar and the Oct. 4 GI Oak Tree Turf Championship going a mile and a quarter at Santa Anita. Poteen, third in last year's G1 English 2000 Guineas, is winless in nine starts since taking a race at Newmarket in April, 1997, but missed by only a neck when second in the G1 Lockinge S. May 16 and ran a solid third despite traffic problems in the Sept. 20 GIC Woodbine Mile in his North American debut. He gets blinkers on for his second start on this side of the Atlantic.

In the last race of her career, Tomisue's Delight displayed the final-furlong flourish which made her a multiple Grade I stakes winner. After a similar come-frombehind win in the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga, the four-year-old filly was second to Sharp Cat in the GI Beldame Oct. 10 at Belmont and fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff three weeks ago over this track. 
