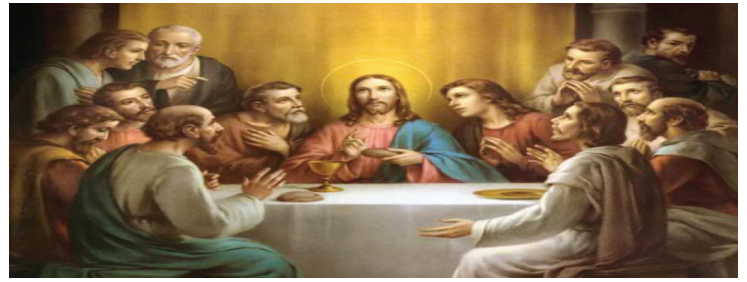

Dear Parishioners,

With news of the possible overturning of Roe vs Wade in the news, I wanted to dedicate this letter to offering resources for anyone considering an abortion or for anyone who needs help, healing, or hope after one.

Regina Maternity Services

This Diocesan-run Community Case Management Program provides case management, crisis intervention, and parenting education to low-income pregnant and parenting mothers with infants and toddlers living in Nassau or Suffolk Counties. Their Case Manager meets with each mother individually to assess her needs and personal goals. They speak with them throughout the pregnancy to ensure their needs are met and to offer support. They also work with them on positive parenting topics to increase skills in infant care and development, child care, and parent/child bonding. Services are offered in-person at various locations throughout Long Island, as well as virtually.

This office seeks to respect and care for life from conception to natural death. 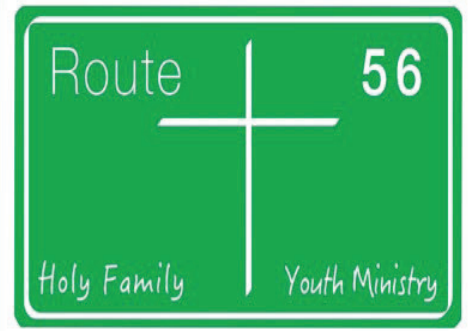

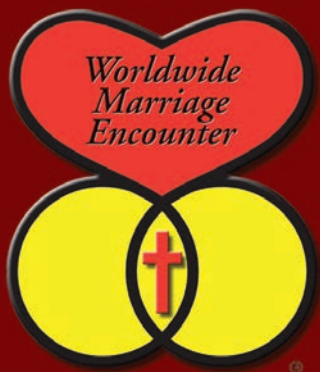

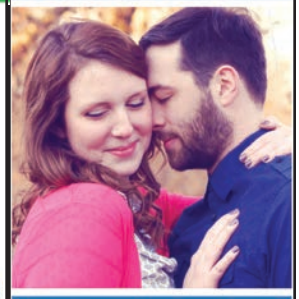
