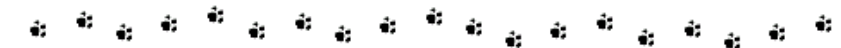
Eileen is a sweetheart who has endured neglect that left her with a useless leg. She has begun to chew at her leg and surgery will give her a second chance at a comfortable life.

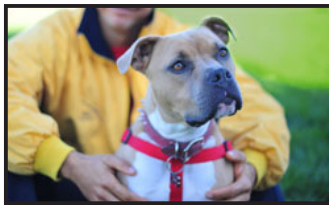

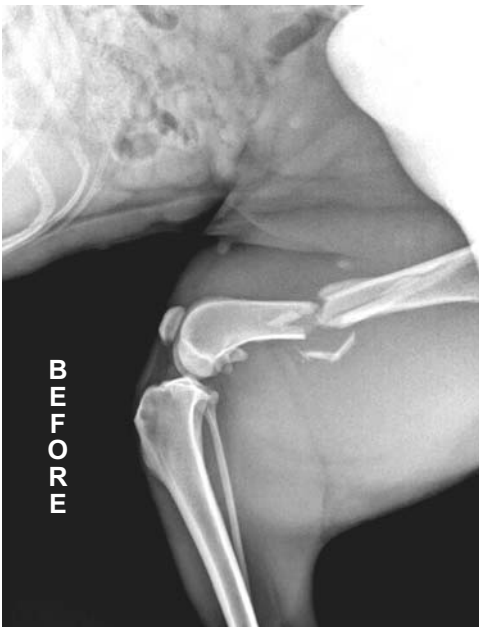
