PUMPKIN SEEDS

**“Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.
2 Corinthians 9:10”**

Oct. 2: Exodus 23:19 - Bless our worship and our sacrifices and our gifts to You, Almighty God.

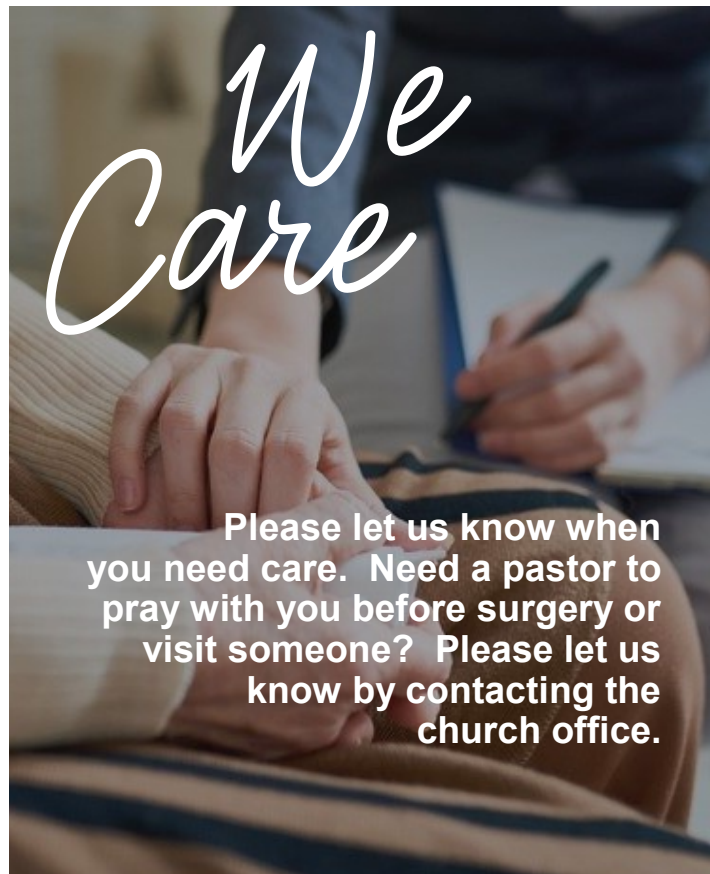
Oct. 3: John 7:51 - Create in us, Lord, a desire for peace and justice for all people.

Oct. 4: Philippians 3:10-12 - Grant us the grace of Your resurrection, O Christ, so that we might see You in all Your glory.

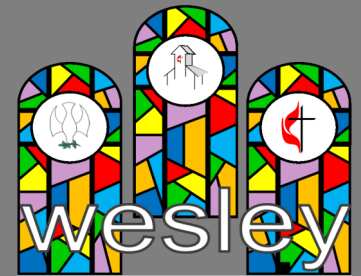
Oct. 5: Psalm 119:49-50 - Remember us during our struggles, Gracious God, and grant to us new life.
