BAPTISM: Sundays at 1:00 PM in the chapel. A required Baptism Class is held on the third Monday of each month in Fr. Anthony Hall. To arrange a Baptism, please contact the Rectory.

RCIA: Adults seeking to enter the Catholic Church or complete their Christian Initiation should contact the Rectory.

MARRIAGE: Arrangements should be made a minimum of six (6) months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

SERVICE TO THE SICK: If someone is homebound or in the hospital, please call the Rectory and arrangements will be made for the person to be visited and to receive the Sacraments.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

My dear people of St. Ann's Parish,

I am suggesting to the parish family of St. Ann's the possibility of changing the 5 PM Saturday evening Mass to 4 PM on Saturdays. It will mean that Confessions will begin at 3 PM.

I will only make this change with the support of the parish community. The main group of our parish family will come from the input of the parishioners who regularly attend the Saturday 5 PM Mass. I realize that not everyone in the parish will be supportive of a change in the schedule or leaving it as it is now, but I would still like your option. After all, it is your parish, and I am here to serve you.

There is a "ballot" in the back of the Church, which will remain until Thanksgiving weekend. Once I have reviewed the community's input, I will make a final decision. If any changes occur, we will take a few weeks to let everyone be aware of the changes, and if no change happens, I will also inform the community.

I am proposing this change for two reasons, 1. I desire to provide an earlier Mass time, especially during the winter, so people can be home as it gets darker outside. 2. There is a 5 PM Mass at St. John the Baptist, so I am only able to be with the people attending the 5 PM Vigil Mass at St Ann's every other week. As you hopefully observed, I come to say "hello" or "good-bye" at each Mass each Sunday, but with two 5 PM Masses in two different churches, I cannot see all my parishioners each weekend. I want to be available to all my people each week, so I do my best to travel back and forth each weekend between the two parishes. Having a 4 PM Mass in one parish and a 5 PM in the other will allow me to be present for both communities on Saturday evenings.

Therefore, please let me know what you think by either filling out one of the "ballots" in the back of the church, sending me an email at fr.norton2001@gmail.com, or speaking to me at Mass on the weekend.

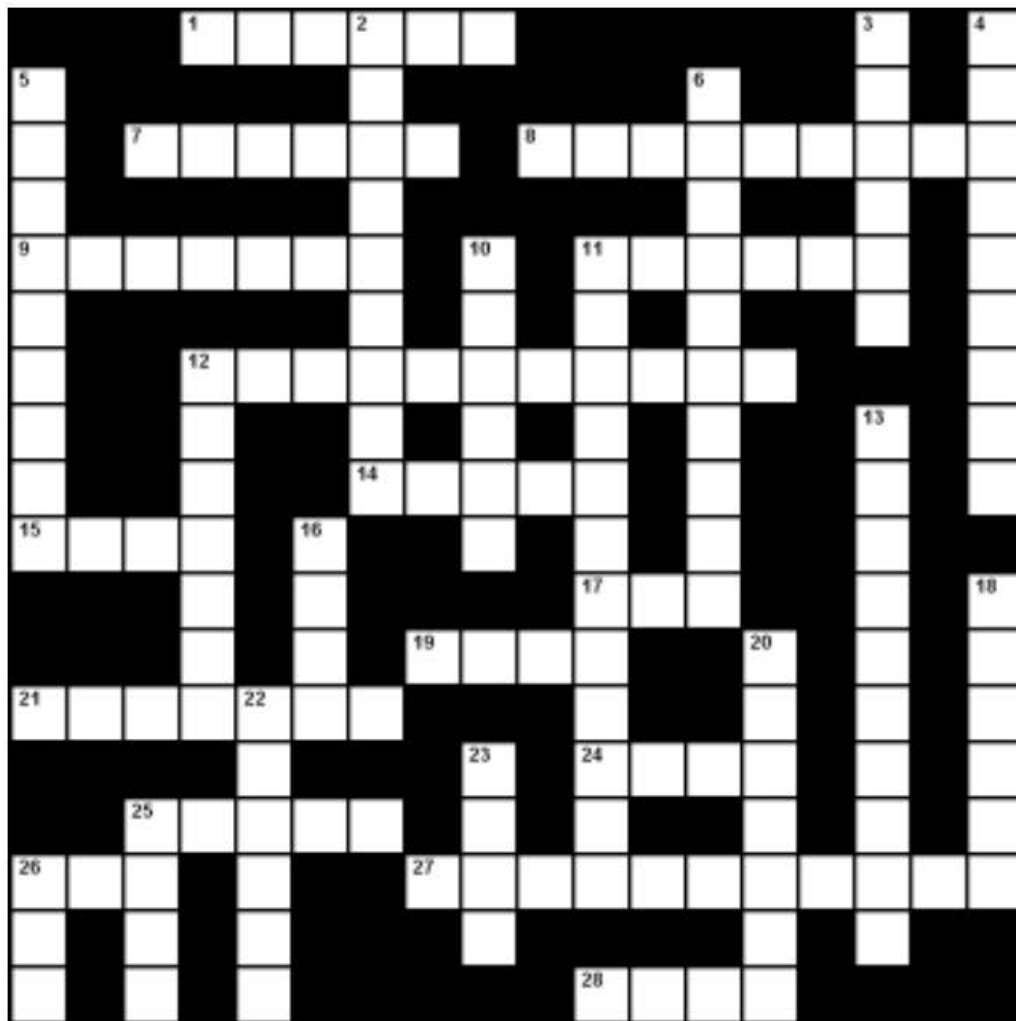
