Due to the relentless hours put in by the Show Committee, the heavy turnout of Patrons, the wonderful work of the volunteers and of course the fabulous vendors our Dallas Quilt Celebration was a huge success. We knew that when we watched the continuous line of Patrons entering the Show, the smiles on everyone's faces, and the compliments that all of us received.
