

## Jumah Guide

A step by step guide to leading the Jumah prayer

## **Manner of Conducting Salatul Jumah**

- **1.** Imam enters the masjid, goes to the Mimbar after the 1st adhan is called
- **2. Imam ascends the Mimbar and turns before sitting and gives** salaam (peace be upon you) to the congregation.
- 3. Imam sits down
- 4. Second athan (call to prayer) is given
- 5. Imam answers the Athan as the congregation does
- 6. After the Athan is completed, the imam stand up, faces the
- congregation and gives the 1st Khutbah (Sermon)
- 7. The Imam sits down after the 1st Khutbah
- a. Time for the congregation to make Duaa (Supplication)
- 8. Imam stands up and delivers the second Khutbah
- 9. The Iqamah (similar to the Azan but made just before performing the prayer) is made after the second Khutbah is concluded and Duaa's made.

## **Requirements for the Khutbah:**


These are the requirements according to the Shafi and Hanbali Schools of thought:

- a. Praising Allah at the beginning of each Khutbah
- b. Making of Salawat on the Prophet (s) for both Khutbahs
- c. An admonition to Taqwa in both Khutbahs
- d. Verse(s) from the Quran to be recited
- e. Some Duaa must be made in the 2nd khutbah (Shafi only)



1. PERFORM THE AZANN (CALL TO PRAYER) FOR SUNNAH PRAYERS 1.1 THEN REPEAT THE AZAAN BEFORE KHUTABA AL HAJJA 2. O You who believe! fear Allâh (by doing All that He has ordered and by abstaining from All that He has forbidden) as He should be feared. 


<b>4. CONCLUSION OF THE FIRST PART OF THE KHUTBAH:</b> The first part is concluded with an invitation to the congregation to make a du'aa (supplication):
أَقُولُ قَوْلِي هَذَا، وَأَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ لِيَ وَلَكُمْ ولِسَائِرِ الْمُسْلِمِينِ ، فَاسْتَغْفِرُوهُ، إِنَهُ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ.
A'koolu kowle haazallaha liya wa lakum wlisaa-e-ril muslameen. Fastaghfiroo ina huwal ghafoorura heem
Meaning (loosely): Make a supplication to Allah, He will accept your prayers & forgive your sins
5. SIT DOWN & MAKE A DU'AA YOURSELF
6. ON STANDING AGAIN: make a Du'aa (Supplication) for our beloved Prophet (pbuh):
بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، والْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ، والصَّلَاةُ والسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وسَلَمَ.
Bismillaa-hi, walhamdullilli wasalaatu wasaalmu alaa rasoolillaahi salallahu alayhi wasalaam
Meaning ( loosely): In the Name of Allah and all Praise is due to Allah; and Blessings and Peace be upon the Messenger of Allah
