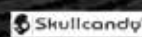

## TRANSPONDERS



This year transponders are required for racing. The racer must check in with 2X PROMOTIONS Timing and Scoring booth across from the food court prior to their first moto and have a transponder assigned to their bike. This will cost the racer \$10. The lap times and scoring is provided to the racer at anytime.

*(Hint) Obtain your transponder during practice days and see your lap times early.*

## HOW TO GET TO THE TRACK—DIRECTIONS & PARKING INFO

Mammoth Lakes is centrally located on the eastern slope of the Sierra Nevada Mountain Range. A scenic drive along US 395 from Reno (to the north) or from Los Angeles (to the south) via Interstate 5 to Highway 14 to US 395 will land you at the Highway 203 junction just outside of town. Exit and follow 203 into town.

The track is located off Sherwin Creek Road, about 2 miles from the intersection of Old Mammoth Road. Signs for parking and the track will be posted.

### DIRECTIONS

Once in Mammoth, take a left onto Old Mammoth Road. Travel about one mile and make a left onto Sherwin Creek Road.

*If already in town and heading east on 203, make a right at the intersection of Main Street and Old Mammoth Road.*

*Hiking and bicycling to the track on Sherwin Creek Rd. is permitted. No pit bikes allowed past the gravel pit.*

### PARKING

Only racers, pit crews and vendors may park at the track. All others, including spectators, must park at one of several parking lots designated for the event. Shuttle busses will transport everyone to the track.

#### THIS IS A MANDATORY SHUTTLE.

The gravel pit on Sherwin Creek Road fills up early, so there are additional parking areas serviced by the Motocross shuttle:

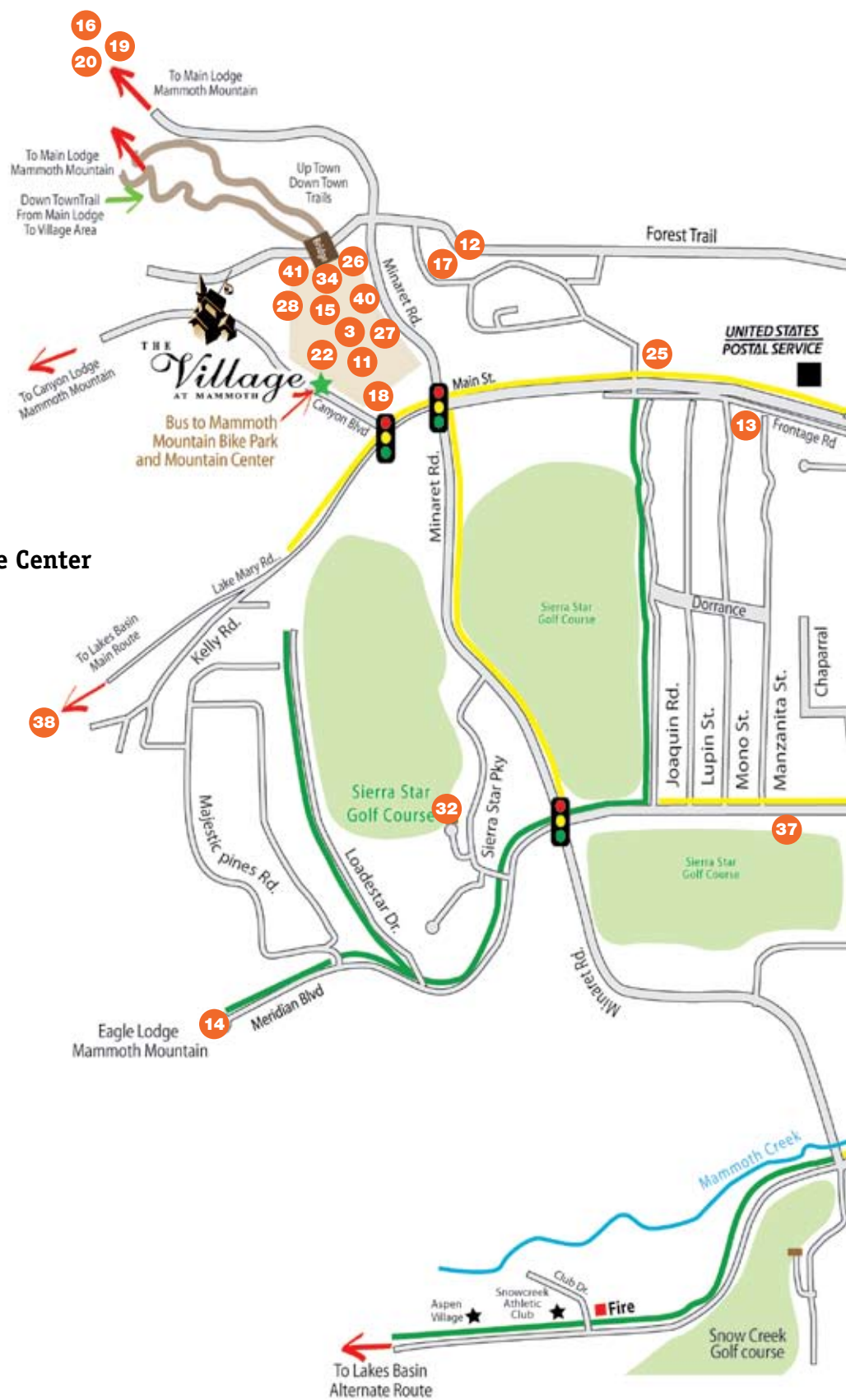
- 1 Gravel pit** on Sherwin Creek Rd. Shuttle every few minutes
- 2 Mammoth High School** on Sierra Park Rd. at Meridian Blvd.
- 3 Park & Ride lot** on Old Mammoth Rd.

*The shuttle operates from town pickup location areas on weekend Race days and runs about once every 30 minutes, if necessary.*

**The** Monster Energy Road to Mammoth, the qualifying event for the Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross, can best be compared to the hole shot in motocross racing: everyone wants it because they know it leads to great results.

In only its second year, the Road to Mammoth (RTM) has motocross track owners lining up to host the event, and participant numbers are steadily rising.

Since room for expansion of the Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross is not possible at the actual Mammoth track because it sits on Forest Service land that only holds a certain number of people, the motocross team, headed by Director Mike Colbert, has maneuvered its way around the constraints it works within, and come up with a different strategy. The solution is holding six qualifying events around the country to motivate racers to compete for one of the limited spots at the Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross.

This year Colbert saw a 20 percent increase in participant numbers at the six qualifying rounds, which took place between January and May.

"We had 500 entries at Pala, which is more than a full race day during the Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross," Colbert said.

New venues for this year's RTM included Honolulu Hills Raceway in Taft, Calif., Pala Raceway in Temecula, Calif., and OMC (Owyhee Motorcycle Club) in Boise, Idaho. Both venues had heard of the RTM in 2010 and, sensing the potential, reached out to Colbert to be included as stops along the RTM for 2011.

"Even though the Road to Mammoth is still catching on, the qualifiers are quite popular and it is going to be huge in a few years," said Darin Layton, co-owner of Honolulu Hills. Layton has been racing Mammoth Motocross since the 1980s, and one of his partners, Charlie Comfort, currently owns a home in Mammoth, so their ties to the area are strong.

Layton and Darrell Melton, the third partner at Honolulu Hills, raced a lot during Mammoth Motocross' earlier years, which was a premiere event even back then.

"We were amateurs and if you won at Mammoth it looked really good on your resume," Layton said. "We wanted to race the best riders and see how we stacked up."

"It [RTM] is a way to grow the event outside [Mammoth] with qualifiers since they can't grow it at the actual track," Layton said. "Honolulu Hills pursued being part of it because we know it has a great future."

Over the years the Mammoth Motocross has become so popular that simply opening the event to general registration was no longer filling the need of potential participants. Entry into the event was based more on the speed of a rider's Internet connection than his or her ability as a racer.

With the RTM, racers now have the option to qualify for the Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross based on skill. There are still a handful of general registration slots, but more than half of the racers competing this June 16-26 have come from the Road to Mammoth.

"I always wished Mammoth had done something like this," Layton explained. "The Road to Mammoth is like the playoffs to the Super Bowl, with everyone fighting tooth and nail to get to the main event."

Another Mammoth motohead for many years, Brian Lueddeke, sits on the Board for the OMC in Boise. He too, realized the potential of the Monster Energy Road to Mammoth and got the rest of the motorcycle club on board.

"I've been going to Mammoth motocross since I was a kid," Lueddeke said. "I started calling last year to get on the list of stops for this year's RTM." The club and Lueddeke were successful and hosted a leg of the RTM in March.

"We had some horrendous weather and a lot of people weren't able to make it, but it was still the marquee event for our organization in the last several years," Lueddeke said. "We really rolled out the red carpet for the riders and the Mammoth crew."

Layton and Lueddeke agreed that the overall vibe of the RTM was very positive.

"I wish the weather had been better, but overall the feedback was good," Lueddeke said.

"The Mammoth crew is great to work with; they are motoheads but additionally they are promoting the entire town [of Mammoth] and community because they realize motocross will continue to put Mammoth on the map," Layton said.

Both Lueddeke and Layton will be competing in this year's Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross. Head out to the track to catch the action, stroll through Expo area and enjoy great dining and retail opportunities.

**Motoheads, welcome to the 2011 Monster Energy Mammoth Motocross! I'm super stoked on the event as I started riding dirt bikes for the first time in my life 16 months ago, and am totally hooked.**

It's no secret that Mammoth possesses world-class fishing very close to town. We invite you to dunk some worms, cast a lure, or delicately place a fly on a stream.

Crowley Lake gets about 500,000 trout planted in its waters every August. Whether you want to dunk night crawlers, flip Thomas Buoyants, or midge fish for trout, there are huge trophies in this lake just waiting for you. Another gem is Convict Lake just northwest of Crowley. Don't miss spending a late afternoon at one of these two locales, either casting from the shore or from a pontoon.

Our trophy spot for bait, spin, and fly anglers is The Owens River. There are plenty of great holes up and down this fishery located southeast of Mammoth. It is wader-friendly and stacked with fish.

If you are a fly angler, Hot Creek is the place to spend a morning. The snowmelt run off is currently moving hard and fast, but you can catch trout if you have the right fly and work under the ledges where the trout are lurking.

Step into any outfitter in town to find answers for specific angling questions, inquire about fly fishing, rent gear, or pick up tackle, bait, flies, and/or your fishing license. Every outfitter also offers guiding service to make the most of your time on the water.

Whether you are a veteran to fishing the Eastside, or have yet to try it, don't leave town without spending some time on the water. It ain't the adrenaline of soaring over a tabletop on a 450, but it certainly is thrilling to find yourself with a bent rod. Go fast, and tight lines.

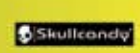

# John Teller's family used to cringe at the idea of him racing bikes during the ski offseason.

Why risk injury, they would ask. Why risk your career on a hobby?

Two reasons. One, both John and his family saw that there was a correlation between his moto results and his skiercross results. The better he rode, the better he skied, and vice versa.

Two, riding is a helluva lot of fun.

A little more than six months ago, I wrote my first story about John Teller.

He was gearing up for the 2010-2011 World Cup campaign (Teller races for the U.S. Skiercross team) and looking to the local community for some financial assistance to help make that happen.

A former alpine racer, Teller had retired from competitive skiing before taking up skiercross a few years ago.

For the uninitiated, skiercross is essentially a Chinese Downhill, but on a set course. Each heat has six participants. First three make it to the next round. Until the finals, when the best man wins.

As Teller says, skiercross and motocross are technically very similar, in terms of body position, using one's legs as suspension, keeping the shoulders level. "Passing, looking for different lines, jumping, endurance ... it all crosses over."

The difference with motocross is that you've got 40 people lined up in the starting gate, as opposed to six. Which is still preferable, in Teller's mind, to racing alpine, where you're the only one on the course. "It's like chasing a ghost," he said. "At least in skiercross, you can see what you're up against."

Teller began racing bikes in the interval between leaving alpine and trying skiercross. A mechanic at Alpine Garage in Mammoth during the offseason, Teller works on his own bike (an '06). He used to race in the Nevada series (Hawthorne, Fernley) but not so much anymore. Generally, he'll just travel down south to a track and ride for the weekend.

At Mammoth Motocross, Teller races in the 450 Junior and Open Junior events. Last year marked the first year he made a main, finishing about 20th in the final.

This came after a few top-20 finishes on the World Cup Skiercross circuit in the final two races of the 2009-2010 season.

"There was definitely carryover [to Motocross] from the World Cup," Teller said.

And there was definitely carryover from Mammoth Motocross to the 2010-2011 ski season.

About six weeks after that Thanksgiving interview, John Teller became the first American to ever win a World Cup skiercross race. He followed that up by winning gold at the X Games in Aspen, defeating the #1 ranked Canadian, Chris Del Bosco, in a thrilling final.

Like Teller, Del Bosco also cross-trains—but as a mountain biker. U.S. skiing great Daron Rahlves, owner of a dozen World Cup ski victories and a World Championship gold, not only has moto history, but also used to race jet skis.

With his success this year, Teller's brief fundraising career has come to an end. It lasted all of about three weeks.

In addition to his hometown sponsorship by Mammoth Mountain, Teller is now sponsored by Atomic, and the U.S. Freeskiing team (which includes skiercross, half pipe and slopestyle) is sponsored by North Face.

*Did Teller have any idea he'd be this successful at skiercross?*

**Teller:** I knew I had good ability, but in my first race ... I landed in between a guy's skis off a jump. It was an adjustment. You've got to trust the guys next to you, and they've got to trust you. This is why nobody wants to train with the French. They're all over the place.

*Is moto similar?*

**Teller:** Yeah. There are some guys you want to steer clear of. Every year in practice, a 16-year-old ripper usually takes me out (laughs).

It's been a long road to the top for Teller, 28, but he's got his feet on the ground (he's marrying longtime sweetie Angela Dessert on July 9 at Twin Lakes), his sense of humor intact, and he fully intends to keep his job at Alpine Garage no matter what happens in his career. But things, yes, things are slightly different now than they once were.

*Have people come in and asked for your autograph?*

**Teller:** Yes.

*Have they asked for Mike's (Alpine Garage owner Mike Fiebiger)?*

**Teller (laughing):** That would be a big negative.

The Inyo National Forest welcomes you to 2011 Mammoth Motocross.

The Motocross track and its adjacent facilities are located on National Forest System lands and are operated by the Town of Mammoth Lakes under a Special Use Permit with the Inyo National Forest.

The 2010 Motocross benefited from the continuous improvements implemented over prior years. The multi-day race format, continued exclusion of pit bikes, improved signing and public information, as well as the provision of funds for additional patrols and volunteers all served to reduce potential impacts from the event. Volunteers in the field greatly enhanced the availability of information to the public. A greater Forest Service field presence was made possible by the employment of a seasonal Off-Highway Ranger, who assisted by providing public outreach and education, by helping prevent damage to vegetation, and by enforcing penalties resulting from riding off permitted routes and violating other vehicle regulations.

It is my hope we can continue to build on last year's success during this year's event. It is critical that riders work together with the Town and the racetrack operator to make sure this year's event is safe, fun, and most importantly that racers and other riders stay within the rules both at the racetrack and elsewhere on National Forest lands. I ask for your cooperation in making sure opportunities like the motocross racetrack remain available to responsible riders.

As in the past, the racetrack will remain closed both before and after the June events. Successful maintenance of the closure remains critical to our ability to hold future events.

I wish you the best of luck in this year's race and hope you will enjoy your visit to the Mammoth Lakes area. # KEEP OUR WILDLIFE WILD

**It is our responsibility in the Eastern Sierra to KEEP WILDLIFE WILD. The best way of doing this, and of preventing bears from becoming dependent on humans for food, is to follow these common-sense rules:**

- Never feed any wildlife or leave food out for bears or other wild animals.
- Securely store food and fragrant items such as shampoo and deodorant in an airtight container.
- When camping, use a bear-proof box.
- Don't leave food, even in a cooler, in a car, tent, or other unsecure location.
- Don't leave pet food outdoors or use a bird feeder. Bears love birdseed!
- Always deposit trash in a bear-proof trash can or Dumpster.
- Keep your car locked and your garage door closed.
- Close and lock all windows when no one is in your camp.

It is not unusual to see black bears wandering through town. Enjoy them, but keep your distance. If you see a bear that is misbehaving, such as trying to get into a Dumpster, vehicle, or building, call 911 immediately. The Town's wildlife specialist and police officers are trained to handle situations such as these. Bears are shy and generally afraid of people. If you feel threatened by a bear, yell or bang on something to scare the bear away. If by chance a bear enters a structure looking for food while you are inside, make a lot of noise, go into another room, close the door, and call 911. The bear will most likely be more frightened than you and leave.

## TRAIL RIDING IN AREA

For those of you who have been coming to Mammoth Lakes to recreate for years, you'll know about all the amazing terrain there is to enjoy. With about 2,000,000 acres of forest, you would think that boredom is impossible.

One of the reasons we almost lost the Ford Mammoth Motocross for good was because of those few people who get "bored" with the hundreds of miles of trail the Forest Service has made available. The concern is not so much breaking the rules. It has to do with the safety of other people, of animals, and of re-growth forest areas.

If we can prove that during Motocross season, off-trail riding can be eliminated, we will have a very good chance to continue the motocross event year after year.

Improper operation of OHVs causes damage to land, wildlife, and/or vegetative resources!

## PLEASE REMEMBER THE FOLLOWING WHILE YOU ARE RIDING IN THE AREA DO'S

### STAY ON OHV ROUTES!

- Respect other trail users
- Ride at a safe speed
- Have your current registration and green sticker visible on your bike (race bikes are an exception to this while in the track)
- Obey all OHV laws.
- Slow down near all campsites & public areas
- Get a map of approved riding before venturing out riding

## DON'T

### RIDE OFF THE OHV ROADS!

- Operate a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Ride recklessly
- Forget your helmet
- Ride on hiking, bicycle, or horse trails
- Rhino/Golf Cart near the Mammoth Motocross Area

## PENALTIES

### IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION FROM 2011 MOTOCROSS EVENT

- Potential discontinuation from future Motocross events
- Fines, determined by the U.S. Forest Service and Mammoth Lakes Police Department.

## BIKE WASHING

### BIKE WASHING IN THE FOREST IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

There are facilities in the Mammoth for washing. Absolutely no bike washing at the track. Enforcement could occur.

# MOTOR VEHICLE USE INFORMATION

## VEHICLES & CAMPING

In general, Motor Vehicle Use (including MOTORCYCLES, MINI-BIKES and ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES) is permitted on existing roads and some trails on the INYO NATIONAL FOREST if they are licensed and equipped in accordance with California State law. HOWEVER, Off-Road and Off-Trail travel is not allowed in the Mammoth Lakes area. In addition, several old trails near the motocross track are closed to vehicle travel to prevent conflicts between motor vehicle users and others, such as hikers and horse back riders. These closed trails are posted.

There is no parking permitted on Sherwin Creek Road or on the access road to the motocross track. Once the parking area at the track fills up, all additional vehicles will be required to park in Town or at the Sherwin Gravel Pit. The pit is located approximately a mile and a quarter from the track and is served by shuttle bus. All spectators will use the provided shuttle bus to get to the track.

Travel on graded dirt and gravel roads that can be used by conventional passenger autos is restricted to vehicles that are "street legal" according to California State law (lights, muffler, license plate, operator's license, etc.). An exception, and the exemption is limited only to practice and competition sessions, is that competitors with pit passes will be allowed to ride their bikes on Sherwin Creek Road between the Sherwin Gravel Pit and the Sherwin Creek Campground only. This is allowed only for the competitors, and competitors need to respect other users of the road and the adjoining natural resources. No pit bikes will be allowed at the track; only race bikes will be allowed in the track area. Please observe posted speed limits. Once pit parking is full, all other users will need to either use the bus or walk.

The Motocross Track will be a closed track (event maintenance, practice and race only) from June 7-28. During this time period, Mammoth Mountain Ski Area is allowed to charge a track fee for practice.

ATV operators must comply with California State law, which prohibits carrying passengers, requires the wearing of helmets, and requires operators under age 14 to be supervised by a parent or authorized adult who is in possession of an ATV Certificate, and operators age 14 through 17 to be in possession of an ATV Certificate.

All vehicle use within campgrounds is limited to entering and leaving the campground. "Cruising around the Campground" is prohibited. Contact the Forest Service Visitor Center for information regarding areas where you can ride.

### CAMPING INFORMATION

Camping near the Town of Mammoth Lakes is limited to DEVELOPED CAMPGROUNDS ONLY. Camping or campfires at the Motocross track are strictly prohibited.

Rough camping in undeveloped areas away from the Town of Mammoth Lakes is allowed on most of the district. Campfire permits are required if you are planning to have a campfire or use a stove or barbecue outside of an enclosed vehicle. The use of campfires is subject to restriction depending on fire danger. Contact the Forest Service Visitor Center in Mammoth Lakes for permits and information on dispersed camping and fire restrictions.

Forest Service Officers will be actively patrolling the vicinity of the Motocross and camping areas and will be available to provide information and issue campfire permits. These officers will also be enforcing our regulations concerning public safety and resource protection.

# MAMMOTH MOTOCROSS RULES & INFO

## MAMMOTH MOTOCROSS RULES

### RULE #1: HAVE FUN!

No kicking, biting, scratching or hitting below the belt. We are all here to have a good time. Any person not having a good time will be sent home. It's all about fun. This is a family event and we need to conduct ourselves in a reasonable manner.

Entries are non-transferable and cannot be sold. All motos are final 15 minutes after finish of moto.

### PROTESTS

To protest illegal size of motorcycle you must post \$500 (Two Stroke) \$1000 (Four Stroke) and be in the same class of rider you are protesting. One half of the Dollars goes to the bike owner if it is legal. One half stays with us for administration. Anyone protested for age in Vet or Senior class must produce a valid ID to race officials. You must be in the same class of rider you are protesting. If protesting rider ability level you must produce verification (on-line proof, recent result sheets.). You must be in the same class of rider you are protesting. Vet riders cannot step down a class for Regular Jr. or Int. races. Example: A Vet Pro cannot ride in Regular Int. class, or a Vet. Int. rides as a Regular Jr.

Rider must be at the line for the start.

You must start your first moto to be able to start your second moto or qualify for the Main. You cannot skip first moto and ride second moto to qualify.

Adjustments on race day may be made to qualifying totals if divisions are not equal. Starting positions on gate for first moto is determined by draw on a first-come basis. Starting position on gate for second moto is determined by first moto finish. Starting position on gate for Final is determined by position from qualifying races and division.

If you jump gate at start you will be penalized one lap.

You will be disqualified if you pass or ride unsafe during a yellow flag.

### SUPERCROSS FORMAT

Racers with more than one division: Event staff will post the numbers of riders transferring to Main Event. If you transfer from first moto you go directly to Main Event. If not you ride in second moto and try to qualify for the Main Event. Results in Main Event are final results for this race; all qualifying positions will come from main.

### MOTOCROSS FORMAT

Races with only one division of racers will be scored on a two-moto format with the second moto being the tiebreaker. Check your race schedule to determine how your race will be scored.

### SCHOOLBOY AND SUPERMINI

AMA A Rider may compete (not \$ pro rider). All rulings are made by referee and are final.

### EQUIPMENT CLASSES

**Vet/Senior/Master:** All size bikes are allowed for the running of these classes.

### MINI RULES AND CLASSES RULES

**65cc:** Mod classes only. Stock may run in Mod class (Stock Bore and Stroke).

**85cc:** 7-11 Yrs 2 Stroke 85cc only, (No big wheels. No 150f. Stock Bore and Stroke. 15"Rear Max).

**85cc:** 12-13 yrs 2-stroke 85cc, 150cc 4-stroke (Stock Bore and Stroke. 15"Rear Max).

**85cc:** 14-16 Yrs 2 Stroke 85cc, 150cc 4-stroke (Stock Bore and Stroke. 15"Rear Max).

**85cc Open-16yrs:** 85cc Two Stroke, 150cc 4-stroke (Stock Bore and Stroke. No big wheels).

**Supermini:** 112cc two stroke/150cc 4-stroke

**Women:** Up to 250cc 2-stroke, 250cc 4-stroke, (No 450).

**Open Classes:** New this year! All bikes, 125-500cc 2-Stroke, 250-450 4-Stroke. (21" front. No Minis).

**250cc Class:** Up to 150cc 2-stroke, 250cc 4-stroke)

**85cc Open-16yrs:** 85cc 2-stroke, 150cc 4-stroke (Stock Bore and Stroke. No big wheels).

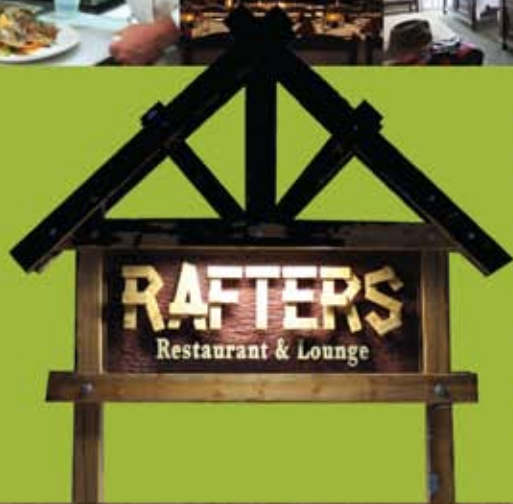
