# **Guest Parking Greeter Ministry Is Off To a Great Start**

The Guest Parking Greeter Ministry has become quite effective in greeting first-time guests. It is easy to forget how confusing our large campus is to a first time visitor. Do the adults, children and youth go to the same building? If not, where do we go? These are just a few of the questions that a first-time guest might ask. Vera Jones is leading a small team of ladies that are on a rotation schedule. One or two will stand at the Visitor Parking spaces in front of the Sanctuary to greet, answer questions, and place a very nice brochure in their hands that will tell them where to go with a map that shows how to get there. Men, we need you to volunteer to assist in this important ministry. Contact Vera Jones or call the church office to join this team. And we need East Side to make sure to leave these parking spaces open for first-time guests.

### East Side Kiosk in Church Foyer

We are installing a kiosk in the church foyer to make it easier to sign up for an activity or a particular ministry or to make a contribution online. You will also be able to submit a change of address or contact information, all in a few easy strokes. We should have it in place with instructions by early June.

#### East Side Finances

In the last of a series of articles I will discuss church cash flow and why we do not publish individual salaries. For the past several years we have tried to maintain one month's expenses in the general budget checking account. Each year the amount varies because the budget varies. One month's budget amount this year is \$116....We are currently below that target amount due to weak December and February offering. In those two months we have snow and ice that interfered with Sunday attendance. We have made some very encouraging gains and will continue to work hard to bring it up to the target amount.

East Side currently has seven full-time and one part-time ministerial staff members, four support staff members and two custodial staff all full-time. As the size of our staff grew it became necessary to just publish the total salary expenditures. Not everyone has the same job requirements, experience or qualifications, and will not make the same salary. The Personnel Team, Finance Team, Pastor Chris and I know. The Pastor and I make salary and raise recommendations based on qualifications and performance to the Personnel Team. They make recommendations to the Finance Team, who will determine if the church can afford it.

If you have any questions about the church finances, please feel free to ask me or stop by the office.
