Nuedexta: Medication to Treat Uncontrolled Crying or Laughing

A medication has been approved for a symptom of MS that is not commonly talked about. The medication is called Nuedexta, and it is marketed by Avanir Pharmaceuticals. Nuedexta is supposed to treat pseudobulbar affect (PBA) or Involuntary Emotional Expression Disorder (IEED). It is characterized by uncontrolled or exaggerated episodes of crying, laughing, or other emotional displays occurring with minimal or no stimulation to provoke such a response. Studies show that up to 50 percent of MS patients experience PBA. People who have the condition usually have some type of neurologic disorder, typically MS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, dementia, traumatic brain injury, or stroke.

Nuedexta contains dextromethorphan hydrobromide, 20 mg and quinidine sulfate, 10 mg. A few years ago the medication was almost approved by the FDA under the name Zenvia, but the FDA sent the company back to the drawing board, citing concerns over heart rhythm safety. The main concern was whether quinidine caused QT prolongation (a heart rhythm abnormality that can cause a heart attack). The amount of quinidine was decreased by one-third, and more clinical trials were done. The new formulation will be sold under the name Nuedexta.

Nuedexta is first in its class of medications, thought to affect the neurotransmitter glutamate, although the exact mechanism by which Nuedexta works is unknown. Nuedexta was tested at two strengths: 30 mg dextromethorphan hbr with 10 mg quinidine, and 20 mg dextromethorphan with 10 mg quinidine. Each reduced the PBA rate by 46.9% and 49% respectively, relative to a placebo.

Patients with PBA typically experience embarrassment because of their unpredictable emotional outbursts leading to disruptions of their relationships with family and friends. This can lead to social isolation. It is thought that PBA is a disconnection syndrome that results when regulation of higher centers of the brain associated with emotions are impaired due to disease or injury. Physicians sometimes treat the signs and symptoms of PBA with anti-depressants called serotonin reuptake inhibitors, e.g. fluoxetine, citalopram, paroxetine, and sertraline. The trade names are: Prozac, Celexa, Paxil, and Zoloft. These can significantly reduce the frequency of emotional outbursts, but they can also cause unwanted side effects.

Patients with PBA are frequently misdiagnosed with depression, bipolar disorder, personality disorder and sometimes even epilepsy. One difference is that the previously mentioned disorders have sustained emotional states over long periods of time.

PBA's emotional episodes are relatively short in duration. Usually the patient is laughing or crying, and it is not congruent with what the patient is feeling. A test most commonly used by doctors to diagnose PBA is the Center for Neurologic Study Lability Scale (CNS-LS), a short seven item questionnaire completed by the patient. Another test performed is the Pathological Laughing and Crying Scale (PLACS) which is based on an interview between the patient and the clinician.

Nuedexta is taken once a day for the first week, then two times a day starting on the eighth day. Side effects can be diarrhea, dizziness, cough, vomiting, weakness, peripheral edema, and flatulence. The FDA cautions that quinidine is linked to a risk for severe and potentially fatal immune-related thrombocytopenia (decreased platelets that can lead to bleeding) that can be preceded by such nonspecific signs and symptoms as lightheadedness, chills, fever, nausea, and vomiting. Treatment should be permanently discontinued if thrombocytopenia develops.

Assessment Questions on the CNS-LS Scale:

1. There are times when I feel fine one minute, and then I'll become tearful the next minute over something small or for no reason at all.
2. Others have told me that I seem to become amused very easily or that I seem to become amused about things that really aren't funny.
3. I find myself crying very easily.
4. I find that even when I try to control my laughter, I am often unable to do so.
5. There are times when I won't be thinking of anything happy or funny at all, but then I'll suddenly be overcome by funny or happy thoughts.
6. I find that even when I try to control my crying, I am often unable to do so.
7. I find that I am easily overcome by laughter.

Instructions for filling out CNS-LS: Write answers, using a scale between 1 and 5, with 1 being "never," and 5 being "most of the time." Write down the number that describes the degree to which each item applies to you DURING THE PAST WEEK. Write only 1 number for each item. If you score 13 or higher, you may be having PBA symptoms.
