# From the Pastor's Desk How's Your Relationship with Jesus?

As many of you know, my Ugandan friend, Peter Wamono, recently visited and shared worship and song at Friendship AME Church in the Old Village, Mount Pleasant. Peter is an accomplished musician and pastor who has planted one church in two locations in his hometown of Mbale, Uganda. Currently, he is living in Charlotte, awaiting his next call from God.

It was a joy to have Peter staying with us. We spent much time in conversation, especially about faith. If you met Peter, you would understand that he has completely given his life over to God, and even if you wanted to, you could not stop him from talking about God the Father, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and his experience with all three.

One of the subjects we touched upon was witnessing (sharing Jesus with others). Peter can witness to *anyone*. He asks questions, he listens, he listens some more, he affirms them, and then as he's praying in his mind, he brings Jesus into the conversation. For Peter, he owes everything to Jesus; he believes that. He's developed a personal relationship with Jesus, and the result is that Peter is good at talking about Jesus. Lutherans aren't typically known for witnessing or even talking about Jesus. But perhaps we should be.

Peter begins with the premise that God loves everyone. Everyone is loved by God. He first speaks of the great love that Jesus has for them. "Have you ever heard of Jesus? For me, he changed my life. And he loves you too, more than you can imagine." In nearly every case where people say they aren't Christians, Peter says that it's because they've had a bad experience with church or Christians. He shares with them, "Okay, so imagine you hire a cleaning company to clean your home, but when you arrive home, you find your home still dirty. The cleaning crew did a messy job. Wouldn't you call the manager and complain? You see, the cleaners are like Christians. All too often, we do not represent God's business well. We are messy. We fight. We can be hypocritical. Is that God's fault? No. So, don't you want to know about my relationship with my loving God through Jesus? And what if Jesus truly loved you and can change your life for the better?"

The Lutheran faith is grounded in Germanic and Nordic traditions, which are very scholarly. Therefore, Lutherans tend to be good at *thinking about* God but not necessarily good at *knowing God personally*. However, faith is a *relationship* with our God. That's why Jesus died on the cross, so all our garbage would not separate us from a perfect God. God sent Jesus so we could pray to, hear from, and feel the living God. Faith is not an exercise for the mind. Faith is trusting that what God has already done for us is true. It comes from the heart.

When was the last time you prayed to God as your Father? When was the last time you told someone about how Jesus is getting you through this and that? When was the last time you felt and acknowledged the Holy Spirit's work around and in you?

I believe my friend Pastor Peter is so successful in witnessing to people because he talks about his own *experiences* with God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God in three persons is the source of his life. Maybe we can develop our faith relationship in Jesus and eventually confidently witness to those around us using our own stories.
