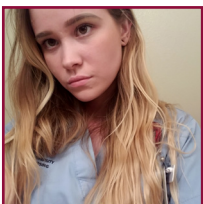
DANICA BROSKY. I am about to conclude my freshman year at California Baptist University with the goal of a career in Nutrition and Dietetics field.

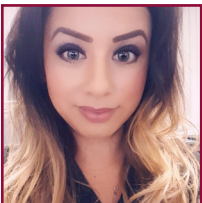
