Cerner CommunityWorks Training Coming Soon!

Training for our September Cerner CommunityWorks implementation will begin in **June.** TJ Regional Health staff and providers will be assigned a combination of e-learning modules and classroom sessions. Here are some important details:

- Training will be role-specific and task-based
- Build a foundation and confidence with e-learning, accessible anytime and from any PC with an internet connection
- Get day-in-the-life, role-specific practice in the classroom
- **E-learning** modules must be complete prior to attending classroom sessions
- Classroom sessions will begin at the end of July
- A network of peers will be assembled to help coach you through the training process

What are Next Steps?

- Watch for an email notification from Cerner in June once your Learning Journey has been assigned
- Once you receive your notification, simply login to the Cerner Learning Portal as indicated in the announcement and start completing your modules

- Be sure to check your benefit deductions on your upcoming pay check on June 11, 2021.
- Any errors must be reported to Human Resources by **JUNE 30**, **2021** for corrections to be made retroactive and reimbursed to June 1, 2021.
- If an incorrect deduction is not reported to Human Resources by that date, corrections will be effective the first of the month following notification of the error, but you will not be reimbursed for any amount.
