A proposal to increase the cattle check-off (levy) in BC from \$3 to \$5 per head will be presented to the annual meeting of the Cattle Industry Development Council. Special guests will report on work successes and plans related to the check-off funds. This meeting is your opportunity to learn about the proposed increase in the check-off and to share your views.

The Canadian beef industry came together to develop the National Beef Strategy presenting a 5-year plan about how organizations can work together to best position the Canadian beef industry for greater profitability, growth and continued production of a high quality beef product of choice in the world. Achieving the Strategy goals requires an increase in the national check-off from the current \$1 per head to \$2.50 per head. The provincial levy which supports project work of the four provincial cattle associations is proposed to increase from \$2 per head to \$2.50 per head.
