## **B. Primary Course Responsibilities:**

**DH 431 (3hr) Concepts II:** 2002 – *present.* This is a Concepts course which deals with special needs patients and how to care for them in a dental setting. The course material is arranged to give the students an in depth view of various medical conditions that they will encounter and how to avoid medical emergencies with this type of patient. The course emphasizes the practical application of this knowledge in various patient populations.

**DH 407 (3hr) Ethics and Jurisprudence:** 2001 – present. This course teaches ethical values for dental hygienists in the clinical office setting. Students prepare presentations on various ethical dilemmas and how they would handle them. The Kansas Dental Practice Act is used to explore the legal guidelines surrounding dental and dental hygiene care. Resume preparation and practice management skills taught in preparation for clinical practice.

**DH 434 (4hr) Clinical Dental Hygiene III:** 2001 – present. This is the second clinical course that students rotate through in the Delta Dental Wichita State University clinic. Students spend two full days a week providing care to patients from the surrounding area as well as WSU students. My responsibilities include scheduling students in their clinical rotation, calibrating and scheduling faculty, tracking clinical requirements, and handling student issues.

**DH 435 (4hr) Clinical Dental Hygiene IV:** 2001 – present. This course is the third and final semester in clinical rotations. My responsibilities are the same as DH 434 as well as preparing the students for clinical boards and licensure.

#### On line Education

DH 420 (3hr) Educational Methodology in Dental Hygiene: 2012-2014.

Seminar dealing with the implementation of teaching and learning theory and its application in the formation of a course of instruction. Students gain experience in teaching undergraduate students in laboratory/clinical settings.

**DH 452 (3hr) Community Dental Health Management:** 2005 – 2012. This course focuses on the oral health care delivery system and the role of the dental hygienist in managing oral health care. Emphasizes community and dental health settings and populations underserved by the current private practice setting. The course is handled completing on line and is able to meet the needs of the practicing hygienist who may not be in close proximity to the campus.

**DH 462 (3hr) Special Project in Dental Hygiene:** 2005 – 2012. This is individual study of selected topics, didactic and/or clinical, to enhance the student's knowledge base and competencies in clinical or community dental hygiene practice. Students are licensed and working in dental settings. Students are advised on an individual basis and projects are assigned according to each student's clinical situation.

**DH 468 (3hr): Field Externship:** 2005 – 2010. Students implement and evaluate a community dental health project or research project. This may include an area of interest or concern in community dental health or clinical dental hygiene. Each student is advised on an individual basis according to their interests and develops a research project.

## **Laboratory Instruction**

**DH 104 Radiology Lab**: 2001-2009. Students learn how to clinically apply the theory of exposing, processing, and mounting dental x-ray film. Students use manikins for this semester until competent. The following semester, the students begin exposing radiographs on patients.

**DH 416 Pain Management**: 2001- present. Students learn clinically how to give dental anesthesia along with nitrous oxide sedation. They perform on each other until competent and use their skills on patients the spring semester. This lab is team taught and I am responsible for working with 7 students.
