Boys Football and the Netball Trials will commence the week beginning Monday 21st August. An invitation to register will be sent at the beginning of the Autumn Term.



AUTUMN SWIMMING 17.18

The school swimming programme for 17.18 will commence in August. A weekly schedule will be included in the school newsletter and will be available for viewing on the PE Noticeboard outside the gym for the duration of the programme.

All children are required to attend these essential life skill lessons. Please provide a valid doctor's note should your child be unable to swim.

In Term 1 swimming caters for children from Y2-6. Y1 will swim in Term 3.

Y2 pupils will have two swimming lessons a week in Term 1, receiving 11 lessons in total. Y3-6 children will have one lesson a week, receiving 6 lessons.

Cost is \$80 per child, per session. So the total cost for Y2 will be \$880 and for Y3-6 the total cost will be \$480. The swimming fees are added to the Termly cost. This price is excellent value and covers the cost of the swimming teachers and the hire of the pool.

In case of inclement weather, the swimming teachers will go to the classroom and teach water safety to the younger students and simple, practical water safety techniques to the older children.

To be prepared for swimming every child requires:

Kennedy School swimming kit - swimming costume or shorts/jammers.

Swimming caps are highly recommended and compulsory for ALL children with hair below the tops of their ears.

Large white t-shirt or swim robe

Waterproof shoes, crocs or sandals for walking to and from the pool.

Large towel, preferably a beach towel.

A strong waterproof bag.

Swimming kit, swim caps and swimming bags are all available from the PTA Office.

A rash vest is highly recommended for sun protection but is not compulsory. Swimming goggles are also recommended. Please ensure these are measured to fit your child prior to their lesson to avoid your child losing pool time.

The 3rd International Zhou Youguang Cup Chinese Talent Show (Hong Kong) was held on 17 June at Kennedy School. Nearly 150 students from Kennedy School competed against some 200 students from 24 schools in Hong Kong.

The awards ceremony held on 24 June was a great celebration of the hard work and preparation from all involved. Almost 50 Kennedy students won prizes. Of the winners, Roshan Relwani (6M) and Sean Ye (5A) were named Champions of Chinese Cultural Competition, the highest title awarded to only four competitors. Roshan was also chosen to be the "Chinese Culture Ambassador", who will become the image ambassador showing up on Hong Kong region's poster for the year. With the largest number of students participated in the competition and their excellent performances, Kennedy School won the award of The Best School.
