Many of us will be going on journeys during the three months of summer...and our scripture readings for the summer reflect this theme in 2019. The summer lectionary encompasses much of Jesus' first journey – through Galilee and toward Jerusalem to preach, teach and perform signs the "the kingdom of God has come near to you" (St. Luke 10:9). Our Gospel Reading for the summer is Luke...and in Luke, Jesus is seen ministering to those who are lowly...on the margins of life – widows, sinners, the sick and downtrodden.

Once Jesus is on his way to Jerusalem, Luke shares two stories on the difficulties of discipleship (two disciples can't follow Jesus whole heartedly and turn back... and the Seventy are sent out with the reminder that they may well be rejected – despite their ability to cure the sick and proclaim the Kingdom.)

The Gospel readings for the remainder of the summer invite us to pay attention to the marks of discipleship: loving others; listening to and learning from Jesus; prayer; giving and generosity; healing and liberation; humility.

I hope that during these times of journeying for many of us...that you'll journey to church MOST Sundays during the summer. Remember when you're away to find time to worship...I can give you information on summer worship spots should you need them!


Make this craft to show appreciation for your dad or another special man.
