Another tidbit of information from the AARP Magazine:

TAX BREAK: AARP Pennsylvania wants to be sure members know that the deadline to apply for the state's Property Tax/Rent Rebate program has been extended to December 31st.

Residents 65 and older, widows and widowers 50 and older, and people with disabilities 18 and older may be eligible. The annual income limits are \$35,000 for homeowners and \$15,000 for renters, not counting half of the applicant's Social Security income. Last year, nearly 600,000 Pennsylvanians received rebates of as much as \$975 for homeowners and up to \$650 for renters.

To apply: Go to <u>revenue.pa.gov;</u> under Popular Services, click on Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program. Or call 888-222-9190 (toll-free)

Sue Epler mentioned that the Chapter received a grant to be used to "Answer the Call of those in Need" – bags for the Homeless Project. She used the grant to purchase 12 bags for the homeless kits. Each bag consisted of the following items: an All-in-One Poncho/blanket that can be used as a blanket, padded seat or a poncho. The kits also included a towel set, hygiene kit, socks, pens and puzzle book with pencil.

The bags are to be distributed to homeless shelters (veterans, domestic violence). Good job, Sue, doing the shopping and assembling the kits for distribution to the Clubs.
