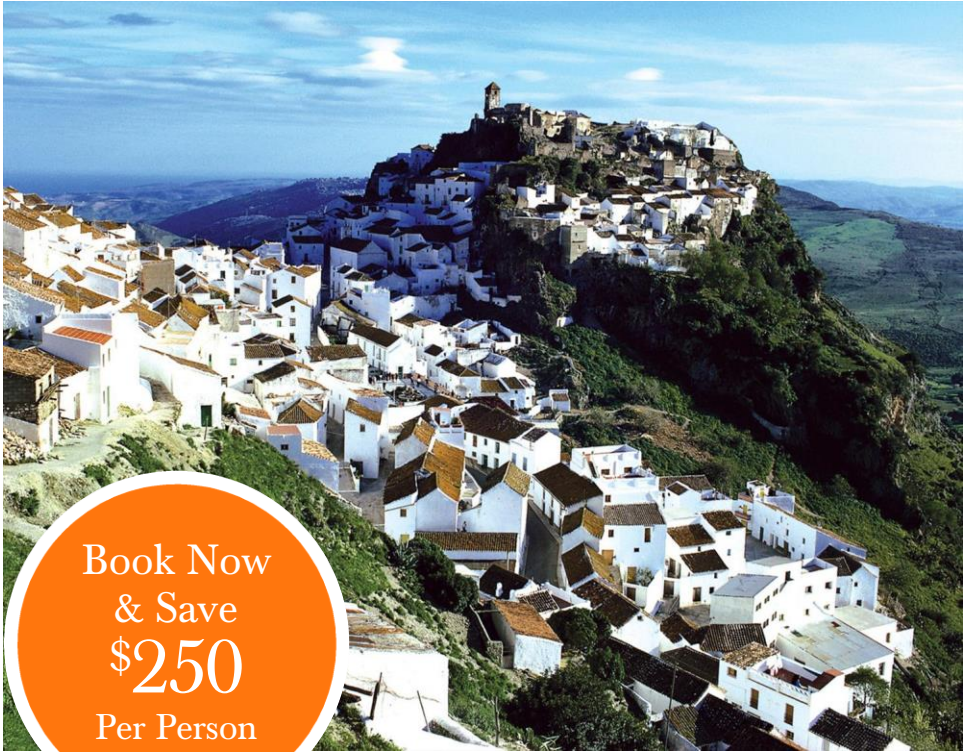

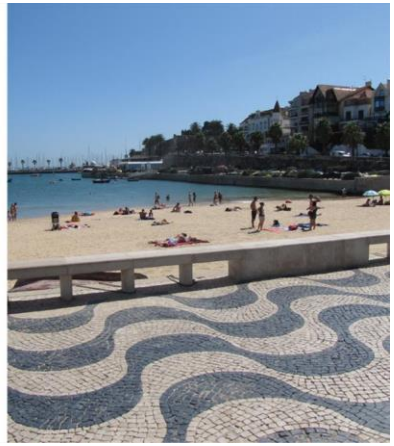

Day 1: Thursday, February 19, 2015
Overnight Flight

Day 2: Friday, February 20, 2015
Madrid, Spain - Tour Begins

Welcome to Madrid, Spain's dynamic capital city. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, February 21, 2015

Madrid - Prado Museum Ease your way into the local culture as your tour manager teaches you a few key phrases of the native language. Enjoy a locally guided tour of Madrid's historic center. See the Puerta del Sol and Plaza Mayor. **Join a local expert to explore the priceless masterpieces of the Prado Museum which opened in 1819 and boasts the world's finest collection of art by masters such as Velazquez and Goya.** Your afternoon is at leisure. Day 4: Sunday, February 22, 2015

Costa del Sol Spend a day at leisure to relax and experience the best of this cosmopolitan coastal region. Stroll the sandy beaches and promenades or linger at a traditional café. Your tour manager will be on hand to help you plan your day. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, February 24, 2015

Costa del Sol - Granada - Costa del Sol Take a day trip to Granada, the last great capital of the Moors in Spain. Travel past rolling hills dotted with olive groves, capturing the country's classic beauty. **Upon arrival, join a local expert for a tour of the world-famous Alhambra, a**

Seville - Azeitao, Portugal - Cascais** Depart Spain and travel through the Portuguese countryside to Azeitao – an agricultural village known for red wine, olive trees and country estates. **Enjoy a tour and tasting of local wines when you visit a centuries-old wine maker.** Later, arrive in Cascais, the famous and picturesque coastal resort on the Portuguese Riviera. A guided tour takes you through the domed basilica, the royal apartments decorated in 18th century furniture and paintings, and the magnificent Baroque library, one of the finest in Europe. Dinner at Cozinha Velha Restaurant (The Old Kitchen), Queluz Palace \$85 USD

Queluz National Palace is one of Portugal's most sumptuous palaces. Built in 1747, the palace was long used as the summer residence for royals and is the country's finest example of Rococo architecture. Nowadays, this palace is used by the Portuguese State as a residence for government and state chiefs that visit Portugal. Located in one of the palace's wings is Cozinha Velha Restaurant; once the kitchen of the palace, it still has the charm of yesteryear. Cozinha Velha is an endearing place, built in grand style with the original rectangular layout and structures. Today, it is considered one of Portugal's finest restaurants with a colorful dining room favored by those seeking a gourmet dinner in a romantic setting. The dining room is like a small chapel, with high stone arches, a free-standing fireplace, marble columns and a 20-ft marble table laden with baskets of fruit and vases of flowers. Enjoy a delightful 3 course dinner prepared according to the most genuine recipes of Portuguese traditional cuisine, complete with wine, coffee or tea and mineral water. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 25 passengers is required. Lisbon by Night (Fado & Folklore Dances Dinner Show)

Fado: the perfect blend of voice and guitar. A shawl, a guitar, a voice and heartfelt emotion---these are the ingredients of Fado (UNESCO's World's Heritage Cultural Patrimony), the celebrated form of world music that captures what it is to be Portuguese. Fado is the song that harnesses the Portuguese soul. The word Fado comes from the Latin fatum, which means fate or destiny. It is a style of music that is all about deep feelings: the disappointments of love, the ups and downs of life, the sadness and longing felt for someone who has gone away, the everyday life of the neighborhood and the conquests of the local inhabitants. No one knows quite how Fado first came into being, but to this day Portugal's traditional music remains at the very heart of the country's culture. At Timpanas, one of Lisbon's most popular Fado and Folklore restaurant in Portugal, professional performers entertain you while you enjoy a wonderful, three course, candlelit dinner of regional Portuguese cuisine and wine. A fado dinner and show is an experience that you simply have to include when visiting Portugal. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 25 passengers is required. Gibraltar & Puerto Banús

The tap dancing, steps using both the sole and heel, is characteristic of the men's dancing while the women's is made up of gracious body and hand movements. Enjoy watching these professional artists with their own choreography of the different songs and dances of the difficult art of Flamenco.
