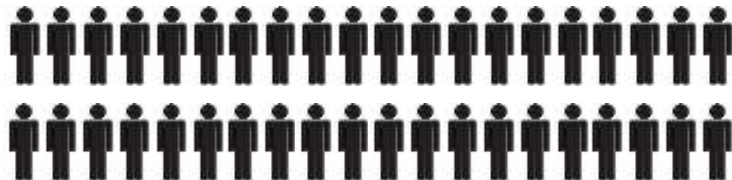

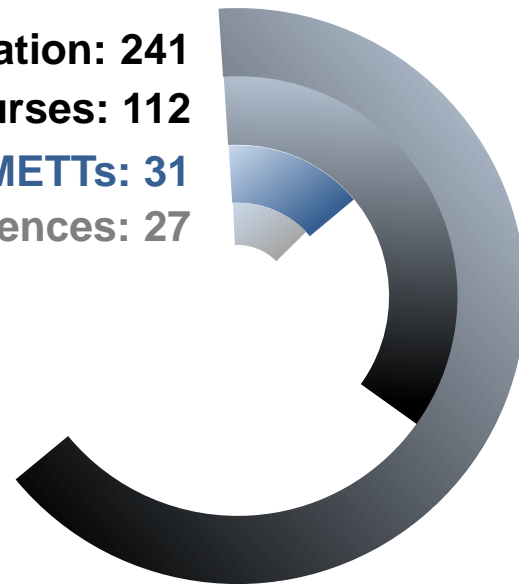

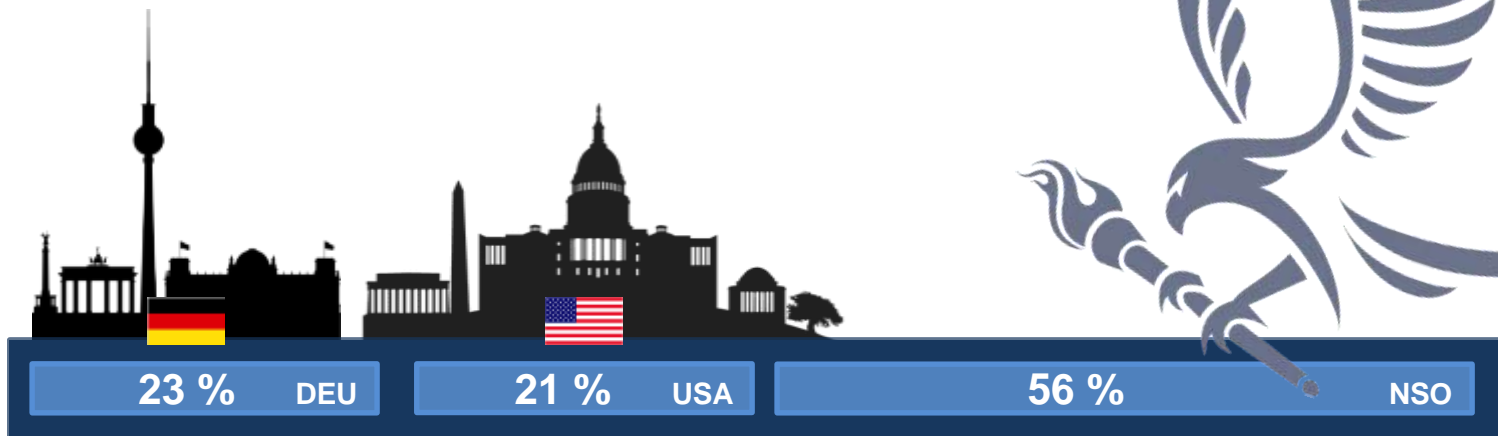

- Responsibilities as CS in the International Setting.

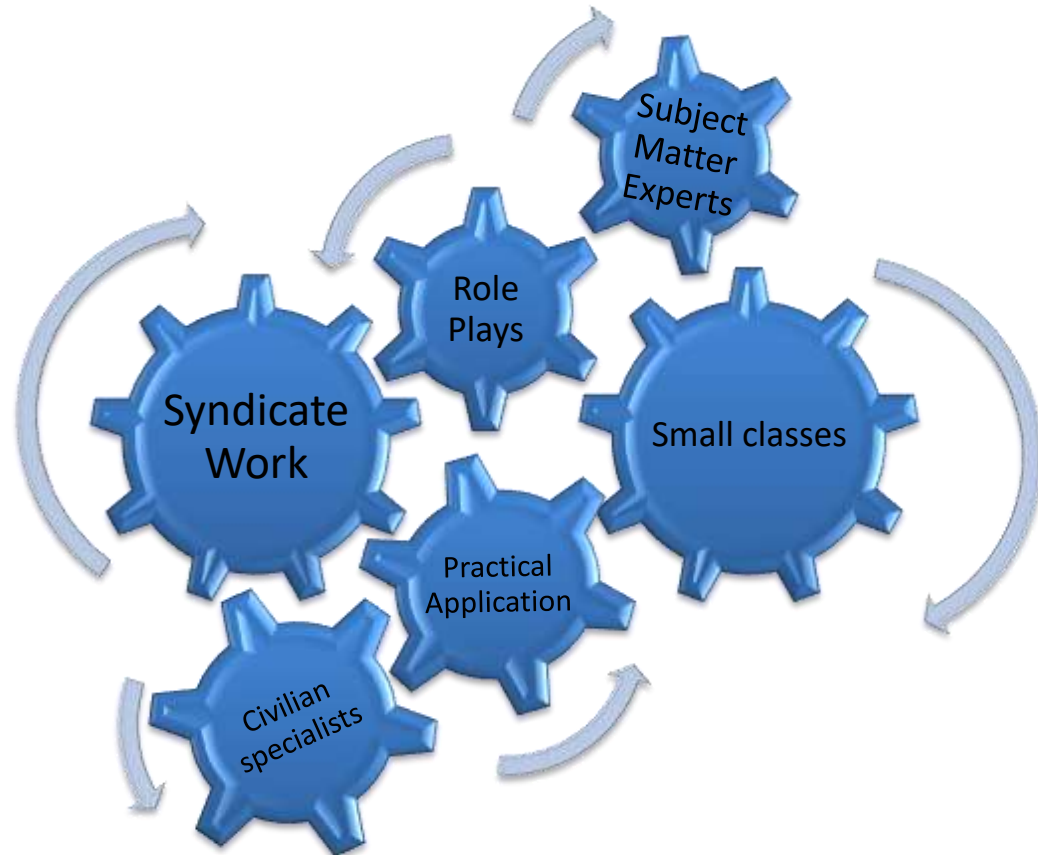

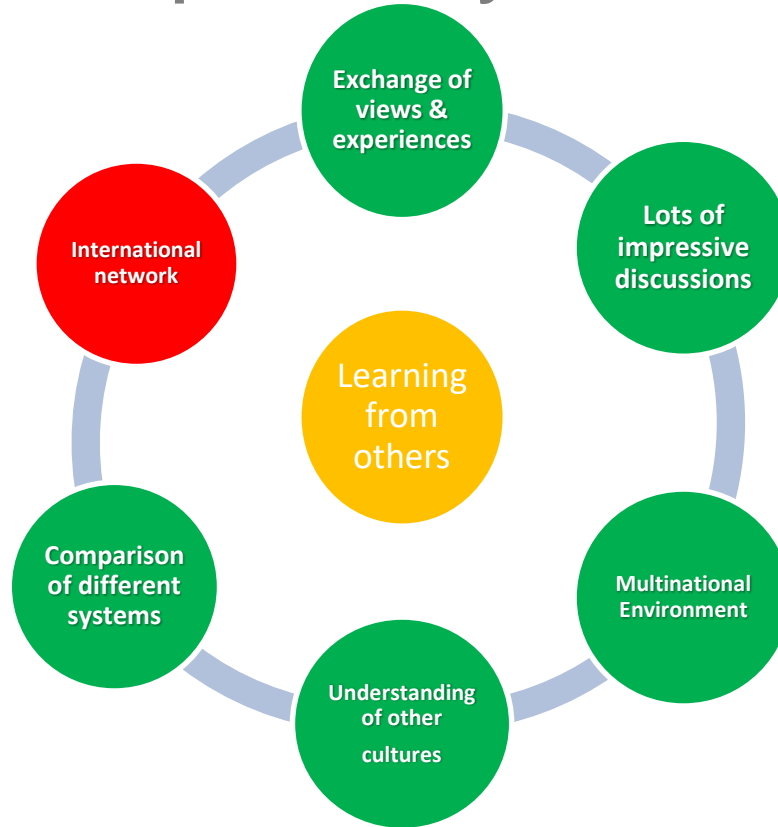
