Clay roof tiles offer exceptional sound insulation

Roof tiles reduce external noise by up to 30 decibels which is more than twice the noise reduction achieved by other commonly used roofing materials. This means that roof tiles reduce the intrusion of external noises into internal living areas.

Clay roof tiles won't rust or corrode

Roof tiles are rust and corrosion resistant which means they are suitable for installation in even the harshest coastal environments.

Clay roof tiles are fire resistant

Roof tiles are ideal for use in bush fire areas because they are non combustible.

Clay roof tiles are strong and durable

Clay roof tiles must comply with strict quality standards and are actually stronger than standard concrete roof tiles.

Water collected off a tiled roof is safe to drink

Water collected from a tiled roof is as safe to drink as water collected off most roofing materials. The raw materials used in the manufacture of modern roof tiles are non toxic and even when oxidised do not pose a health risk.

Clay roof tiles are re-usable and recyclable

Clay roof tiles can be reused by moving them from one roof and installing them on another home without the need for further processing before re installation. At the end of their useful life clay roof tiles can be ground down and recycled in the manufacture of various clay products.

Repair and replacement

Because a tiled roof is composed of a large number of small pieces, damaged tiles can be removed and replaced with relative ease. This not only reduces costs and saves time but also reduces energy expended in production of the material required to repair the roof. Competing alternatives require entire sections of the roof to be replaced even when only a small section of it is damaged.
