# General Information

## Klondike Location

Rock Ledge Park 534 W. High Street, Seymour, WI.

## Patrol Size

Each patrol competing must be made of between 4 and 8 Scouts.

## Arrival / Check in Process

All units will arrive on Saturday morning. As units arrive, you will unload your gear and move your vehicles to the overflow parking lot.

## Headquarters

The Klondike headquarters will be the Scout House.

## Bathroom Facilities

Bathrooms and portable latrines will be in the park.

## Parking

Parking is limited so please try to bring as few vehicles as possible.

## Buddy System

Please remind all Scouts that the Buddy System should be used at all times. Campers should never travel alone.

## First Aid

Each unit should bring their own first aid kit. The First Aid area will be located at the Scout House. Any emergencies should be reported immediately either to one of the activity leaders or by calling the headquarters. Activity leaders will have a radio to contact HQ.

## Patches

Patches will be distributed to Scoutmasters.

## Frying Pan

The coveted frying pan will be awarded at closing!

## Dutch Oven Cookoff – Adults only

Adults are invited to participate in a Dutch oven cookoff Saturday. All dishes must be prepared at the event, not in advance. We are asking that you make enough so that after the judges sample it we can put some out for people to sample at lunch. Please bring your own hog pans or Dutch oven table, charcoal, and all food. The coveted Golden Spatula will be awarded!

## Lunch

Lunch will be provided; **participants should bring a can (or 2) of non-cream soup to share for friendship soup, AND a reusable mug for the hot cocoa that will be served throughout the day.**

## Directions to Rock Ledge Park

**From North:** Take 41S to 29W to 55S into Seymour. Turn right onto High St.

**From South:** Take 41N to 55N to 54W. Turn North onto Main Street. Turn Left onto High Street.

**From East:** Take 54W, turn North on Main Street, Turn Left on High Street.

**From West:** Take 54E, turn North on Main Street, Turn Left on High Street.

## **Patrol Equipment Required**

The following is a listing of equipment that each patrol should have with them in their sled as they compete in each event.

- Patrol Flag
- Current Written Weather Report
- Pocket Knife
- Rain / Snow Gear
- 2-20 ft. ½” Diameter Rope
- Pencil or Pen
- First Aid Kit
- Blanket
- 2 – 8’ poles to build stretcher
- Leg sized splints
- Triangle bandages
- Compass
- Flint & Steel or Hot Spark Kit
- A ice cream bucket of fire building materials – no flammable liquids
- Trail-in Inspection Sheet
- Tarp
- Supplies to build a shelter
- Two cans of non-cream soup for each person attending
- Mug for hot cocoa
- Klondike Sled

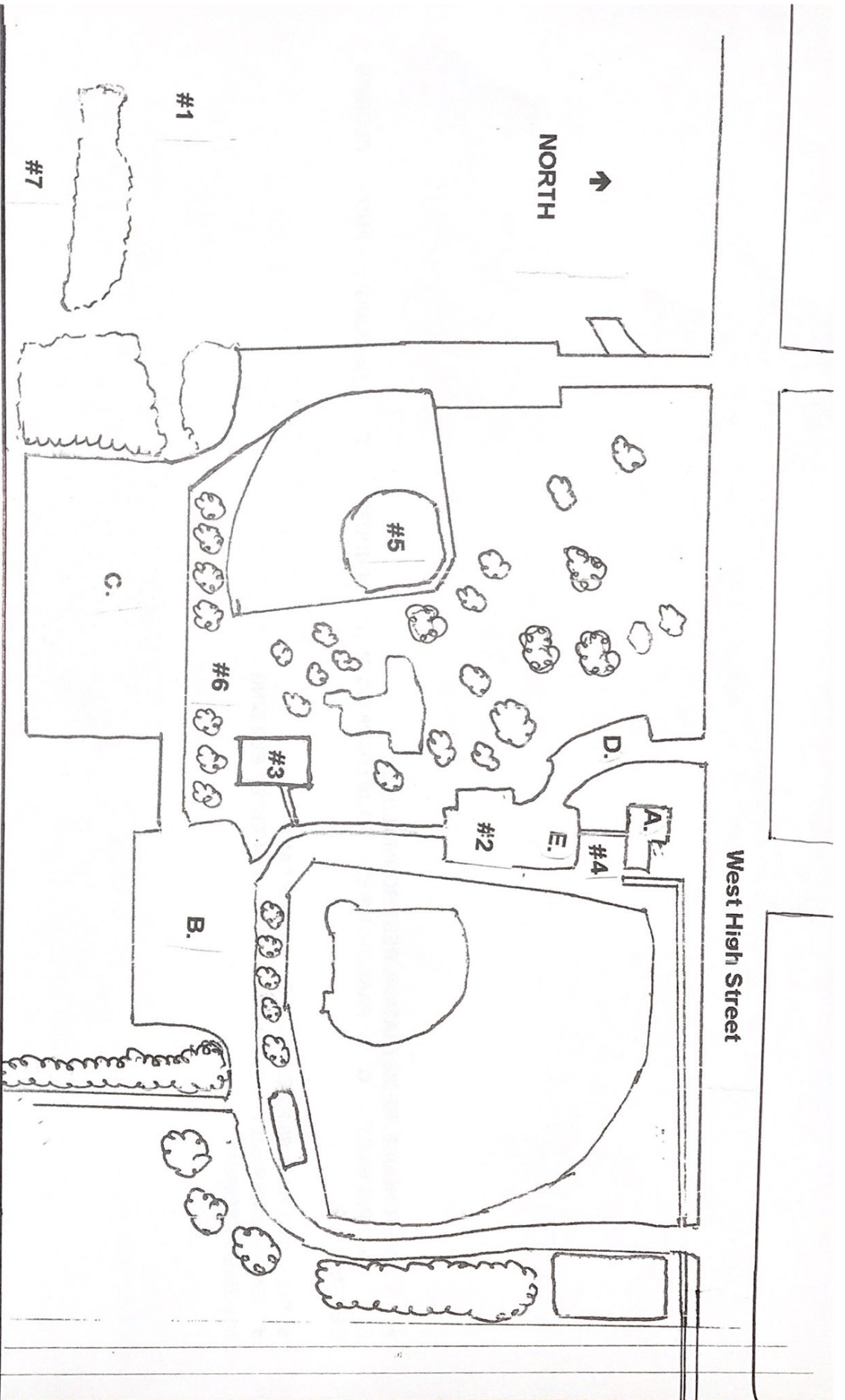
