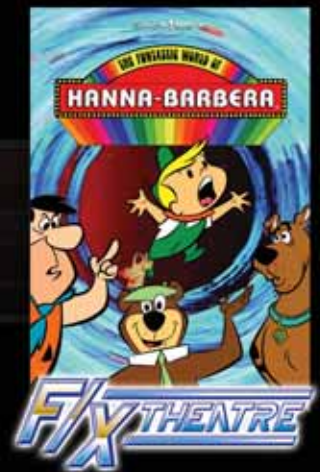

Please note that there will be no changes permitted with the team order or category order for any reason. Your team will compete in your assigned category, in the assigned time-period. This event will follow PCA Competition standards PCA ALL MUSIC format.
- Teams are NOT required to include a cheer in their routines. Teams that cheer will not be penalized, but will only have it scored as part of the over-all category.
- Teams are responsible for providing their own music and a person to start and stop the CD.
- Music must be provided in CD format.
- Please do not use re-writable CDs.
- Timing starts at the first obvious start of music, movement or cheering and stops upon the obvious completion. Entry and exit are not considered.
- Routines exceeding the time limit will receive a 3 point deduction.
- The competition floor is 54' x 42' and is covered with gym mats.
- There is no penalty for stepping off the matted area.

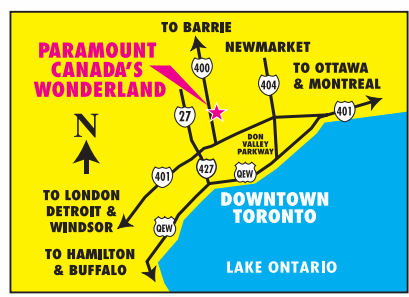
