- Teams are NOT required to include a cheer in their routines. Teams that cheer will not be penalized, but will only have it scored as part of the over-all category.
- Teams are responsible for providing their own music and a person to start and stop the CD.
- Music must be provided in CD format.
- Please <u>do not</u> use re-writable CDs.
- Timing starts at the first obvious start of music, movement or cheering and stops upon the obvious completion. Entry and exit are not considered.
- Routines exceeding the time limit will receive a 3 point deduction.
- The competition floor is 54' x 42' and is covered with gym mats.
- There is no penalty for stepping off the matted area.
