Earning High School Credits

How many credits will you get for passing a class for one semester?

5 Credits

What is the minimum grade needed to pass a class?



"D-". An "F" receives no credit

A student taking 6 classes per year...

6 Classes x 5 Credits per semester = 30 credits per semester
2 Semesters x 30 credits per semester = 60 credits per year
60 credits x 4 years = 240 credits possible

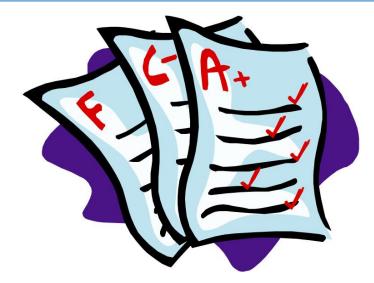

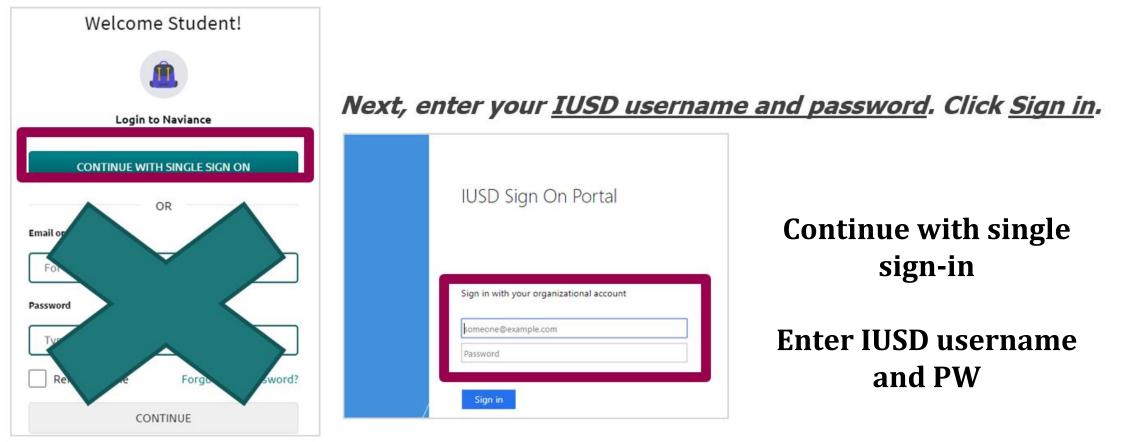
