REMEMBER

We put the verbs *be* and *have* at the beginning of the question.

We use *be* with adjectives (*tall*, *short*) and *have got* to describe hair.

Present continuous

(PB p12)

REMEMBER

The present continuous (verb + *-ing*) is about now. Some verbs take away the *-e* (*make* → *making*). After a vowel and a consonant, we double the consonant (*run* → *running*).
