Blue Raider Basketball Notes

Lindsey Wilson-Georgetown All-Time Series

Lindsey Wilson trails the all-time series 5-36, including 4-14 all-time at Biggers Sports Center. The Tigers have won four straight in the series, including 90-66 in their last trip into Biggers last season.

Lindsey Wilson Last Time Out

The Blue Raiders overcame a 20-point deficit to beat Shawnee State University 76-75 at Biggers on Thursday. Jeremiah Diebler and Chase Cox scored 16 and 13 points respectively off the LWC bench to lead the Blue Raiders charge. Lindsey Wilson committed just nine turnovers while forcing the Bears into 21 miscues.

Georgetown Last Time Out

Georgetown solidified its position atop the Mid-South Conference standings with a 78-71 win at second place University of the Cumberland on Thursday. Tyrone Shelley led the Tigers with 25 points.

Lindsey Wilson-Georgetown First Meeting

Georgetown held Lindsey Wilson to just 29.8 percent (14-of-47) shooting, including 2-of-16 from beyond the three-point arc in a 66-52 win on Jan. 15. Three Tigers scored in double figures led by Vic Moses' 14 points, while Kalen Kimberland was the only Blue Raider to score in double figures with 11 points.

Leader of the Pack

Lindsey Wilson leads the Mid-South Conference in a pair of statistical categories. The Blue Raiders lead the conference and is 11th in the NAIA in scoring defense (64.7) and tops in the MSC and 17th in the NAIA in free throw percentage (71.3).

Recipe for Success

Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's eight-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 147-16. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 77-8 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 13-1 when scoring 70 points -- the lone loss came to Pikeville -- and 4-0 when shooting 50 percent.

Recipe for Success -- Part II

Lindsey Wilson is 10-0 this season when the Blue Raiders shoot a higher percentage from the field than their opponents and when they hit at least 35 percent of its three-pointers.

Rebounding Woes

After out-rebounding 12 of its first 14 opponents this season, Lindsey Wilson has been out-rebounded by the opposition nine out of the last 12 games. The last four games, LWC opponents have won the rebounding battle by an average of 13.8 rebounds per game.

Spreen Leading the Charge

Chase Spreen is averaging 18.3 points and 4.7 rebounds per game during the Blue Raiders' three-game winning streak. He scored a career-high 25 points in the West Virginia Tech win last Thursday and scored the game-winner on Thursday against Shawnee State.

Prince of Thieves

Lindsey Wilson's Justin Archie leads the Mid-South Conference and is sixth in the NAIA in steals this season averaging 2.5 steals per game.

Peck Hits 200 Wins at Lindsey Wilson

Lindsey Wilson head coach Paul Peck picked up his 200th career win last Thursday as the Blue Raiders head man. Peck is 202-89 all-time as the Blue Raiders' head coach. He is Lindsey Wilson's all-time winningest men's basketball coach.

Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his ninth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2010-11. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 202-89 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 438-288 overall entering his 23rd season as a head coach. He is 324-221 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the eight years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular-season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
