HR2HR	Spreadsheet Loader	File Based Loader
End to End packaged Integration	Leverages ADFdi	Bulk import from standard data files
 Closed/End to end integration Restricted source systems (Oracle EBS, PeopleSoft) 	 ADFdi Spreadsheets for loading objects supported by HR2HR Flattened containers 	 Data conversion utility that will load data from a standard flat file Loads complex business objects like Person and Worker Supports Date Effective history and high volume for full data conversion of supported objects

- Use a third party ETL Tool




Step 3 – Data Mapping

1. Upload Source File


2. Upload Target File

3. Load Files into memory



Lessons Learned




- Choosing Effective Dates wisely is critically important
- Loading the "Department" and "Location" objects can be done relatively quickly
- Loading the "Person" and "WorkRelationship" objects take more time
- Email addresses are tied to Security



Required Skills

- Fusion HCM functional knowledge
- Legacy System functional knowledge
- Detailed oriented
- Data conversion experience




