

Welcome to Pecan Square. Where the people are friendly, the land is beautiful, and life is good.


A new community is blossoming on the Texas prairie. Designed to feel fresh, but familiar. Like the town you grew up in. Or wish you had.



A flexible work space, with work stations, meeting rooms, and all the conveniences you need—but close to home.\*




THE LAWN

Online shoppers (pretty much everyone) will appreciate secure lockers for Amazon package pickup.\*




THE ARENA
