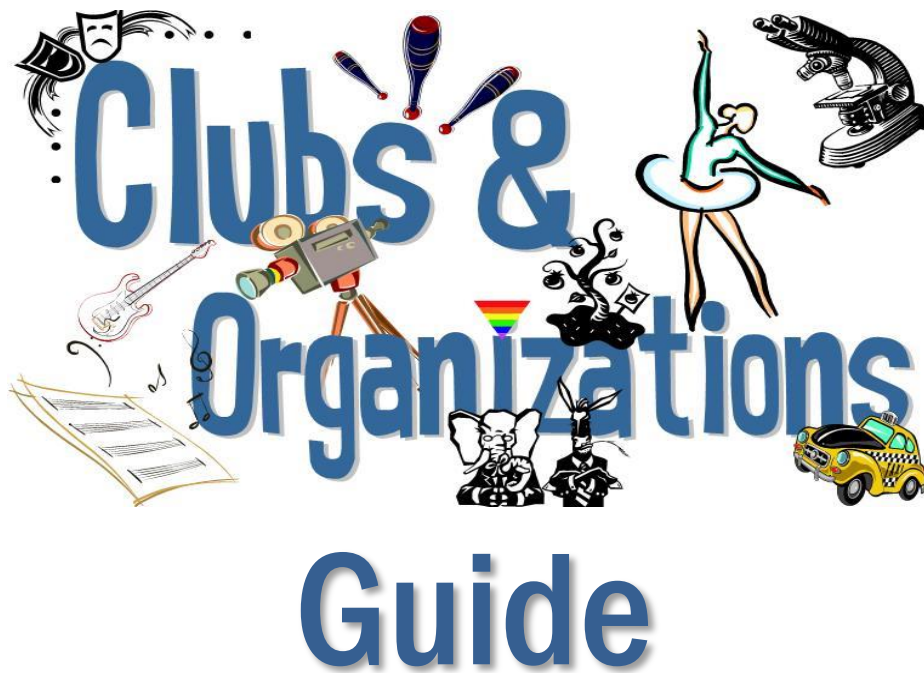

ACADEMIC CLUBS

Athletic Training Club:

Facilitate athletic training, raise student awareness and knowledge in the field through guest speakers and conferences; and take on duties to bring all levels of trainers together, both as friends and students. The club has sought recognition by extending fundraisers and services to the community and surrounding communities.

Biology Club:

The purpose of this organization shall be to serve as a meeting place and time for the persons interested in biology or biology-related topics and fields.
