**Summary**: This report includes:

1.) FIVE 60-MINUTE VIDEOTAPES of selected scenes from U.S. Geological Survey videotapes, depicting the effects of the Loma Prieta Earthquake of October 17, 1989. Filming took place between October 18th and December 9th, 1989. Video equipment consisted of a Sony DXC-7K camera, Sony VO-6800 3/4-inch portable recorder, various microphones and accessories, and Ampex 197 3/4-inch videotape.

Public domain footage of the 1906 San Francisco Earthquake is also included in this report.

The edited tapes of this report were recorded on Ampex 197 3/4-inch videotapes.
