Mailoop Feedback

What is Mailoop Feedback for?

- Mailoop feedback is an « add-in », integrated to Outlook
- Express your feedback about an email or meeting in complete confidentiality
- Once a month Mailoop gives you access anonymously to agglomerated data
- This feature is useful when Mailoop is deployed within a team or a company.



Installation

Manually

Go on mailoop.com to be guided or on the Office store (« complements »)

Automatically

• For a centrally deployed project, **no manipulation is needed** for the user. It only needs to be part of the Mailoop deployment group. To add or remove a user, contact the IT team.



Objectives

Express your feedback.s about:


- The emails you receive (except yours)
- The meeting with at least 2 pers. (when meetings have started)

The feedbacks have been chosen by the project team under Mailoop vigilance:


- They express a feeling, a perception and not a judgment
- They are simple to understand
- They are specific to match targeted actions to set up individually and collectively
- One click is enough to make a feedback; another click to cancel it




Open Mailoop on a Email (Outlook software)




Open Mailoop on an email (on the Web- Outlook.com)




Open Mailoop on an email (on Outlook app)

Onboarding

- Depending on the installation chosen, several scenarios can occur:
 - Personnal installation via the Office store

You have access to all the possible options


- Deployment by IT within your company:
 - 1. IT has identified the features you have access to and limits any additional options (no choice)
 - 2. IT has identified some basic features and lets employees opt for additional options (Smart Deconnexion, Analytics)



Set up Mailoop



1. Choose the Mailoop functionalities



3. A Microsoft page opens to give the necessary access to Mailoop according to the chosen functionalities



Express a Feedback – Cancel a Feedback



Click on the feeling you wish to express



Click again if you want to cancel





Keep the addin open to often use Mailoop





Pin the addin so that it stays open and updates by checking your emails.

Access to your settings



Click on the settings: a **secure and authenticated** session automatically
opens in a browser

Access to your personal dashboard





Click on the "Dashboard" icon: a **secure and authenticated** session

automatically opens in a browser

Enable / Disable Smart Déconnexion (if selected by the company)


- At the first use, you will be able to define your parameters. They can be changed at any time in your settings.
- When Smart Disconnect is turned on, your **emails are marked as read** and no longer generate notifications on your devices on the tracks you have set.
- At the end of a disconnection range (night, weekend, holidays), the e-mails switch back to unread for processing.
- At any time, you can interrupt this cycle by disabling the Smart Déconnexion



Mailoop Dashboard

Objectives

- The dashboard summarizes all the analyzes made by Mailoop.
- It is personal and confidential only you can access it.
- The data are updated weekly or monthly (according to information system).
- A "Settings" tab allows you to customize some features of Mailoop, or to exercise your right of opposition.




The Smart Déconnexion

Objectives

- La Smart Déconnexion is a smart notification shield: it activates itself automatically (according to your preferences) in the evening, on weekends and during your holidays to protect you from email notifications..
- At any time it is possible to **voluntarily consult your emails**: they are simply in your inbox, marked as "read", and with the category "Smart Déconnexion".
- You can stop the automatic Smart Déconnexion cycle by setting it to "OFF".
 About 50% of people prefer to manage solicitations in real time: this is your choice.
- At the end of the disconnection session, the emails switch to "Not Read" in order to be processed in the office.
