





Trojan / Backdoor

- Dropped files
 - Usually in %windows% or %system% directories
- Autostart
 - HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run
 - HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run Once
 - HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\ Windows NT\CurrentVersion\Winlogon
 - %USERPROFILE%\Start Menu\Programs\Startup
