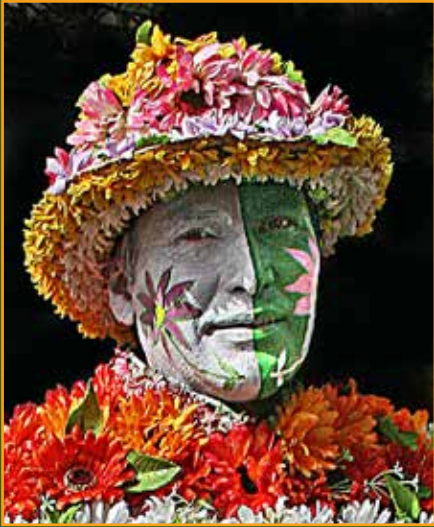
Special Thanks . . .

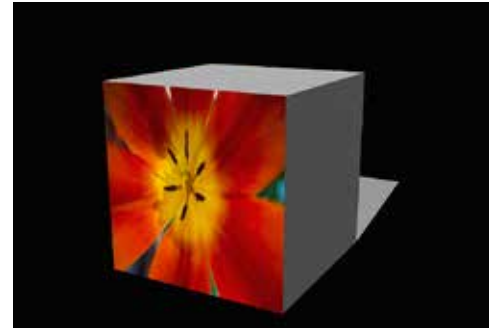


to the Mermaid Parade in June in Coney Island, we find an ever increasing number of people who are taking pictures. They are all participating in an action that has so many wonderful attributes

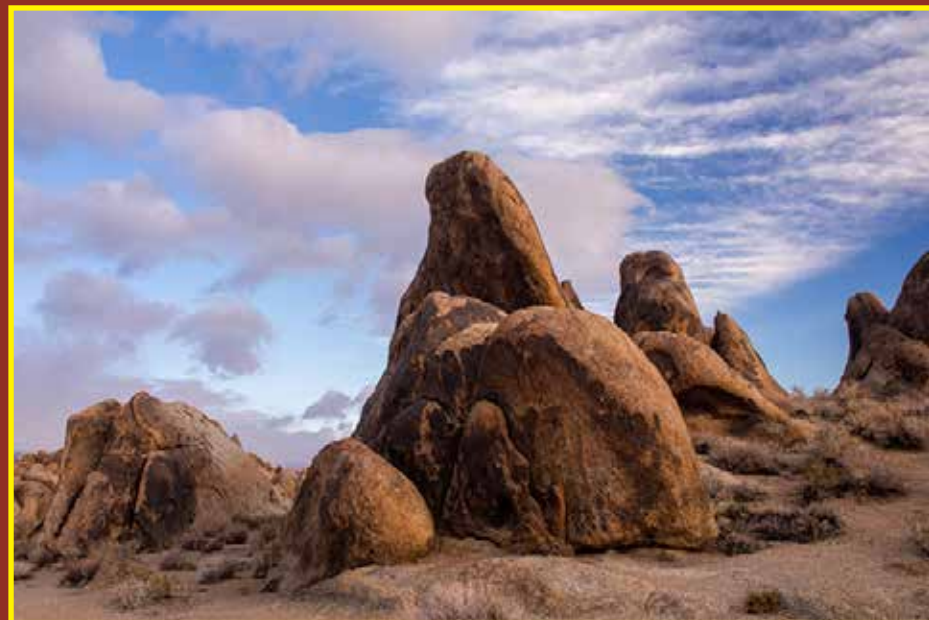
