



#### LIVING AS A MISSIONARY DISCIPLE

The Faith that Saves




Believing in Jesus, says the Bible, leads to Eternal Life. Can any kind of faith save us? We are also told: "You believe that God is one. You do well. Even the demons believe that and tremble." Jas 2:19 Demons believe in God, but they are not saved.

Jesus' death and resurrection is the only reason salvation is possible. Our Catholic Faith teaches us that the grace of salvation is "unmerited", meaning no one can do anything to earn it. Translated into real life experience, this means that if someone is not in the state of grace, they *cannot* decide to repent and put themselves in the state of grace by their own effort. Even if we are not consciously aware of it, a prior grace from God is always necessary before we can repent of serious sin. God must take the initiative, or it won't happen. It is the same with the gift of faith (which is why we call it a gift). This is why we cannot "boast" (Eph 2:9) or become self-righteous about it.

Truly our hearts should sing with gratitude that, "God, who is rich in mercy, because of the great love he had for us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ (by grace you have been saved)" Eph 2:4-5

Jesus is looking for a response of faith, love, and gratitude to the grace He offers us initially. "We love because He first loved us" 1 Jn 4:19. Do I allow Jesus to love me? Do I renew this openness daily? Then I can respond to this love in a way that allows Jesus' salvation to have an effect on my whole person; on every aspect of my life. This is the faith that saves us and brings many along with us in the overflow of grace as missionary disciples.
